



FAFSA

Every student should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is a required application for a wide range of financial aid, including need-based grants, loans, work-study and some UNC scholarships. For fall 2022 financial aid, you can fill out your FAFSA beginning October 1, 2021. You will use taxes from the 2020 tax year to complete your FAFSA for fall 2022.

- Obtain a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) at **fsaid.ed.gov**. Complete the FAFSA at **fafsa.gov**. UNC's school code is **001349**.

- To be considered for other scholarships, submit the UNC Scholarship Application.




Transferology is an online tool you can use to find out if your coursework will transfer to UNC. Knowing how your courses will transfer can save you money and help you graduate on time.
