# 2013 Fall Census

Enrollment Profile and Tuition Forecast

September 11, 2013

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### **Explanation of Enrollment Data**

- 1. The Fall Census date is September 11, 2013. Data included in this report is information captured from the Banner Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW).
- 2. Percent Change in this report is the measure of change from Fall Census 2012 to Fall Census 2013 as a percentage. Caution: When considering % change it is important to note that increases or decreases in categories with low numbers will result in a high percentage change.
- 3. Due to rounding, some graphs may not total 100%.
- 4. Urban Education students are included in Main Campus.
- 5. Colorado School of Public Health students are not included in this summary.
- 6. Funding Summary:
  - a. Headcount: Students counted in Extended Campus have only cash funded courses
  - b. Credit Hours: Main Campus and Extended Campus credit hours are determined by the accounting code assigned to the course.
- 7. Undergraduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 12 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 12 or more credit hours
- 8. Graduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 9 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 9 or more credit hours
- 9. Race/Ethnicity Categories adhere to the reporting standards as mandated by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB). <a href="http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg">http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg</a> notice 15
- 10. Race/Ethnicity is self-reported by the student. Students may leave the question blank and cannot indicate "Do not wish to provide." Non US Citizens are students with a Visa.
- 11. First Generation is defined as a student who reported that neither parent/guardian graduated from a four-year college.
- 12. Low Income is defined as a student who is Pell Grant eligible. Statistics in this report reflect those students who were offered a Pell Grant greater than zero.
- 13. The Graduate Unclassified classification is students who are attending but have not yet been accepted into a Master's or Doctorate program and non-degree seeking students.
- 14. Non-degree seeking graduate students are included in the Graduate School enrollment.
- 15. High School Undergraduates are enrolled students who are age 18 or younger and have not graduated high school or earned a GED.
- 16. New First-time students are not high school undergraduates nor are they Study Abroad, zero credit hour students. New First-Time students are defined as those students who are enrolled in fall and their first term was either the current fall term or the immediate prior term (summer).
- 17. New Transfer Students are undergraduate students who are enrolled in fall as their first term at the undergraduate level and have earned college credit(s) at another institution.
- 18. Freshman classification is undergraduate students with 0-29 credits; Sophomore classification includes students with 30-59 credits; Juniors have 60-89 credits and Seniors have 90 or more credits toward completion of a bachelor's degree.

### **Executive Summary**

#### **Headcount by Classification (Page 6)**

- The total university Fall Census 2013 headcount of 12,084 is down by 413 students, which is a 3.3% decrease from Fall Census 2012.
- Undergraduate headcount decreased by 392 students (3.9%) from Fall Census 2012 and graduate student headcount decreased 21 students or 0.9%.
- Senior classification is 30.0% of the undergraduate population compared to 28.2% at Fall Census 2012.
- Doctoral student headcount increased by 25 students (4.4%).
- The number of graduate Master's students decreased by 4 or 0.3%. Master's students represent 60.1% of those at the graduate level compared to 59.7% in Fall Census 2012.
- 86.6% of all undergraduate students and 71.7% of all graduate students are resident students.

### **Credit Hours by Classification** (Page 7)

- The student credit hour grand total is 148,328, a 3.8% decrease from Fall Census 2012.
- The majority (85.0%) of the total student credit hours are resident (126,105); 87.0% of undergraduate credit hours are resident and 70.0% of graduate credit hours are resident.
- Undergraduate headcount (see Table Headcount by Classification) decreased by 3.9%, while undergraduate credit hours decreased by 4.4%.
- Graduate headcount (see Table Headcount by Classification) decreased 0.9%, and the graduate Fall Census credit hours increased by 0.7% (116 credits).
- Graduate Licensure headcount (see Table Headcount by Classification) increased by 11.9% and the credit hours increased by 3.0%.

### Funding Summary Headcount (Page 8)

- Main Campus headcount is 89.4% of the total.
- Undergraduate WUE headcount increased 16.0%, or 83 students.
- Undergraduate headcount for students registered in Extended Campus courses increased by 8.7% (29) and Main Campus headcount declined 4.3%, or 421 enrollees.
- Graduate Extended Campus headcount remained the same with 914 students. Graduate Main Campus decreased by 1.4% or 21 students.

#### **Funding Summary Credit Hours (Page 9)**

- Main Campus credit hours (138,074) are 93.1% of the 148,328 total. The percentage in Fall Census 2012 was 93.6% of the total credits hours.
- The undergraduate Main Campus credit hours differ by 4.7% from Fall Census 2012.
- Fall Census 2013 WUE credit hours are 6.2% of the total undergraduate credit hours.
- Graduate Main Campus hours decreased 10 hours, or 0.1% compared to Fall Census 2012.
- The total Main Campus credit hours decreased by 6,339 credit hours, a 4.4% decrease from Fall Census 2012, while the Extended Campus credit hours increased by 4.3% or 423 credit hours.

#### **Course Load Summary (Page 10)**

• The number of full-time undergraduate students decreased by 387 students, or 4.3%. The number of full-time graduate students declined 16 students or 1.6% compared to Fall Census 2012.

### **Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity** (Page 13)

- 25.6% of the undergraduate population is minority. This is a 2.8% increase over Fall Census 2012 (22.8%).
- Within the minority category, the Hispanic classification is the largest and represents 16.1% of the total undergraduate population. The Hispanic classification was 14.5% of the total undergraduate population at Fall Census 2012.
- Undergraduate Native American students decreased 24.4% from Fall Census 2012 (11 students). However, the percentage of Native American students to total students remained constant at 0.4%.
- Undergraduate Asian students increased 2.8% from Fall Census 2012 (4 students).
- White students are 57.5% of the undergraduate population compared to 58.4% in Fall Census 2012, which is a decrease of 317 students.

#### **Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 14)**

- The graduate minority population decreased from 13.5% to 13.1% compared to Fall Census 2012.
- Hispanic graduate students represent 6.8% of the total graduate population, compared to 7.2% Fall Census 2012.
- Non-US Citizen headcount increased by 37 students which is a 22.7% increase over Fall Census 2012.
- Asian students decreased by 9.3% (4 students) and Native American students decreased by 46.2% or (6 students) from Fall Census 2012.

### **Undergraduate First Generation & Undergraduate Low Income** (Page 15)

- Low income is defined as those students who are Pell Grant Eligible.
- The number of undergraduate students who are both first generation and low income decreased by 4.5% in Fall Census 2013.
- Low income undergraduate students are 30.6% of all undergraduate students compared to 31.4% in Fall Census 2012.

### **Undergraduate First Generation and Low Income (Page 16)**

• The percentage of undergraduate students who are both first generation and low income decreased 4.5% in Fall Census 2013 compared to Fall Census 2012.

### **New Student Enrollment (Page 17)**

- The number of non-degree seeking new first-time undergraduate students increased 27.1% (26 students) from Fall Census 2012.
- The number of degree-seeking new first-time undergraduate students decreased 10.9% dropping from 2,218 students in 2012 to 1,976 in 2013.
- New first time degree-seeking graduate students realized a 5.0% change (34 students) compared to Fall Census 2012. New first time non-degree-seeking graduate students decreased by 7.7% or 13 students.

### Students Enrolled in (at least one) Distance/Online Course (Page 18)

- The percentage of undergraduate students enrolled in at least one distance/online course decreased from 21% in Fall Census 2012 to 20% in Fall Census 2013.
- The percentage of graduate students enrolled in at least one distance/online course decreased from 40% to 39% of the graduate population.

#### Students enrolled by Gender (Page 19)

• The percentage of undergraduate females increased 1% to 62% of the total from Fall Census 2012. The percentage of graduate males increased 2% to 28% of the total from Fall Census 2012.

### College Headcount (Page 21)

- The College of Natural & Health Sciences (NHS) undergraduate headcount (3,108) is down 2.1% from Fall Census 2012 (3,176 students) that accounts for 32.0% of the undergraduate total headcount of 9,710.
- The College of Education & Behavioral Sciences (EBS) undergraduate headcount decreased 97 students (8.3%) from Fall Census 2012. EBS graduate student headcount increased 38 students or 2.9% from Fall Census 2012.
- The College of Performing & Visual Arts (PVA) undergraduate headcount decreased 6 students (0.7%) and the graduate headcount for PVA decreased 3 students.
- The College of Humanities and Social Sciences (HSS) undergraduate headcount decreased 141 students (7.1%).
- The Monfort College of Business (MCB) undergraduate headcount increased 5.1%, or 46 students.
- University College decreased by 8.7% (157 students) compared to Fall Census 2012.
- Non-Degree Seeking undergraduate students increased by 15.1% (31 students).
- Graduate School decreased by 27.8% (59 students) compared to Fall Census 2012.

### **College Credit Hours** (Page 22)

- Undergraduate credit hours are down 2.1% in PVA and 1.7% in NHS from Fall Census 2012.
- The HSS undergraduate credit hours decreased 6.9% and University College decreased by 9.7% from Fall Census 2012.
- MCB had an increase of undergraduate credit hours (702) 5.6% compared to Fall Census 2012.
- Graduate credit hours are down 3.4% in PVA compared to Fall Census 2012.
- Graduate credit hours are down 36.6% in MCB or 41 credit hours compared to Fall Census 2012.
- EBS graduate credit hours increased by 3.8% and NHS graduate credit hours increased by 2.3% compared to Fall Census 2012.


