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Explanation of Enrollment Data

- 1. The Spring Census date is January 24, 2012. Data included in this report is information captured from the Banner Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW).
- 2. Percent Change in this report is the measure of change from Spring Census 2011 to Spring Census 2012 as a percentage. Caution: When considering % change it is important to note that increases or decreases in categories with low numbers will result in a high percentage change.
- 3. Due to rounding, some graphs may not total 100%.
- 4. Urban Education students are included in Main Campus.
- 5. Colorado School of Public Health students are not included in this summary.
- 6. Funding Summary:
 - a. Headcount: Students counted in Extended Campus have only cash funded courses
 - Credit Hours: Main Campus and Extended Campus credit hours are determined by the accounting code assigned to the course.
- 7. Undergraduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
 - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 12 credit hours
 - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 12 or more credit hours
- 8. Graduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
 - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 9 credit hours
 - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 9 or more credit hours
- 9. Race/Ethnicity Categories adhere to the reporting standards as mandated by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB). http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg_notice_15
- 10. Race/Ethnicity is self-reported by the student. Students may leave the question blank and cannot indicate "Do not wish to provide." Non US Citizens are students with a Visa.
- 11. First Generation is defined as a student who reported that neither parent/guardian graduated from a four-year college. Students that did not report are classified as Non-First Generation.
- 12. Low Income is defined as a student who is Pell Grant eligible. Statistics in this report reflect those students who were offered a Pell Grant greater than zero.
- 13. The Graduate Unclassified classification is students who are attending but have not yet been accepted into a Master's or Doctorate program or are non-degree seeking students.
- 14. Non-degree seeking grOaduate students are included in the Graduate School enrollment.

Executive Summary

Headcount by Classification (Page 5)

- The grand total Spring Census 2012 headcount of 11,645 is down from Spring Census 2011 by 62 students (0.5% decrease).
- Undergraduate students decreased 1% from Spring Census 2011, while Graduate students increased 7.2%.
- Undergraduate freshmen decreased 7.5 % (171 students) and sophomores decreased 7.5% (161 students) from Spring Census 2011.
- Senior classification is 31% of the undergraduate population.
- Graduate doctoral headcount increased by 56 students (11.7%) and master's graduate students increased by 45 students (3.4%).
- 59% (1,363 of 2,138) of graduate students are pursuing a master's degree.

Credit Hours by Classification (Page 6)

- The student credit hour grand total is 141,798, a 0.5% increase from Spring Census 2011.
- 89% (111,585 of 125,926) of undergraduate credit hours are resident and 77% (12,290 of 15,872) of graduate credit hours are resident. 87% (123,875 of 141,798) of the total student credit hours are resident.
- Undergraduate headcount (Page 5) decreased 1.0%, while credit hours rose slightly (137 credit hours or 0.1%).
- Graduate headcount (Page 5) increased 7.2% and credit hours increased 3.7% from Spring Census 2011.

Funding Summary Headcount (Page 7)

- Undergraduate headcount for students enrolled only in Extended Campus courses declined by 14.4% (61 students) from Spring Census 2011.
- Total undergraduate resident headcount declined by 87, while undergraduate non-resident and/WUE headcount decreased by 5.
- Graduate Extended Campus student headcount increased 26.7% or 185 students from Spring Census 2011.
- Graduate Main Campus headcount declined by 31 students or 2.1%.
- Overall, students with only Extended Campus courses rose 11.1% and represent 10.7% of the student population.

Funding Summary Credit Hours (Page 8)

- Compared to Spring Census 2011, total Extended Campus credit hours increased 22.0%, an increase of 30.4% in undergraduate credit hours and 17.6% in graduate credit hours.
- Total Main Campus credit hours fell by 0.7% (986 credits) from Spring Census 2011.
- Main Campus credit hours (132,482) are 93.4% of the total (141,798).
- A very limited number of tuition-free credit hours (40) were courses taken by students under the Aims Cooperative Agreement or audited by senior citizens.

Course Load Summary (Page 9)

- The credit hours of full-time undergraduates increased by 1%, while part-time decreased by 1% from Spring Census 2011.
- The percentage of full-time graduates decreased by 1%.

Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 12)

- Approximately 21% of the undergraduate population identify with a minority classification compared to 19% for Spring Census 2011.
- 12.9% of the total undergraduate population are Hispanic.

Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 13)

- The percentage of minority graduate students remained stable at 11%.
- 6.3% of the total graduate student population are Hispanic compared to 4.4% in Spring Census 2011.

Undergraduate First Generation & Undergraduate Low Income (Page 14)

Note: Low income is defined as students who have been offered a Pell Grant.

- 34% are first generation undergraduate students.
- 32% of the undergraduate population are considered low income.

New Student Enrollment (Page 16)

- The number of New Freshmen increased to 132 students compared to 42 in Spring 2011.
- There were 14 more undergraduate New Transfer students in Spring Census 2012 than 2011.
- The number of graduate New Students decreased by 89 students from 2011, while continuing graduate students increased by 243.

Students Enrolled in (at least one) Online Course (Page 17)

- The percent of undergraduates enrolled in a least one on-line course increased 2% from Spring Census 2011.
- The percentage of graduate students enrolled in at least one online course increased 6% from Spring Census 2011.

Students enrolled by Gender (Page 18)

- Females constitute 62% of the undergraduate population, the same percentage as Spring Census 2011.
- 26% of Graduate students are male, down 1% from Spring Census 2011.

College Headcount (Page 20)

- The College of Natural & Health Sciences undergraduate headcount is down 344 (2,696 2,352) students from Spring Census 2011.
- College of Education & Behavioral Sciences undergraduate headcount increased 83 (962 1,045) students from Spring Census 2011.
- 54% of the graduate students are enrolled in the College of Education & Behavioral Sciences.


