Funding Opportunities – Internal

New Projects Program (NPP)

Up to \$5,000 for new projects.

- fall competition due Oct 5, 2016
- spring competition due Feb 15, 2017

Research, Dissemination & Faculty Development (RDFD)

Up to \$10,000 for RSCW.

- fall competition due Oct 28, 2016
- spring competition due Mar 24, 2017

Provost Award for Travel (PAT)

Up to \$5,000 per funding cycle for travel to present, perform or exhibit scholarly or creative works.

- winter competition due Jan 20, 2017
- spring competition due Apr 14, 2017



Funding Opportunities – Internal

Summer Support Initiative (SSI)

Up to \$6,000* for summer RSCW.

- look for announcement in early spring semester
- proposals due mid- to late-March 2017

*plus fringe benefits, 2016 funding levels

Faculty Reassignment Awards for RSCW

Teaching release (one 2-3 credit hour course) for RSCW.

- look for announcement later this semester
- selection and administration conducted by colleges

Faculty Fund for Publications

Up to \$2,000 for publication fees.

- related to books and peer-reviewed journals
- awards will be made on a first-come, first-served basis.

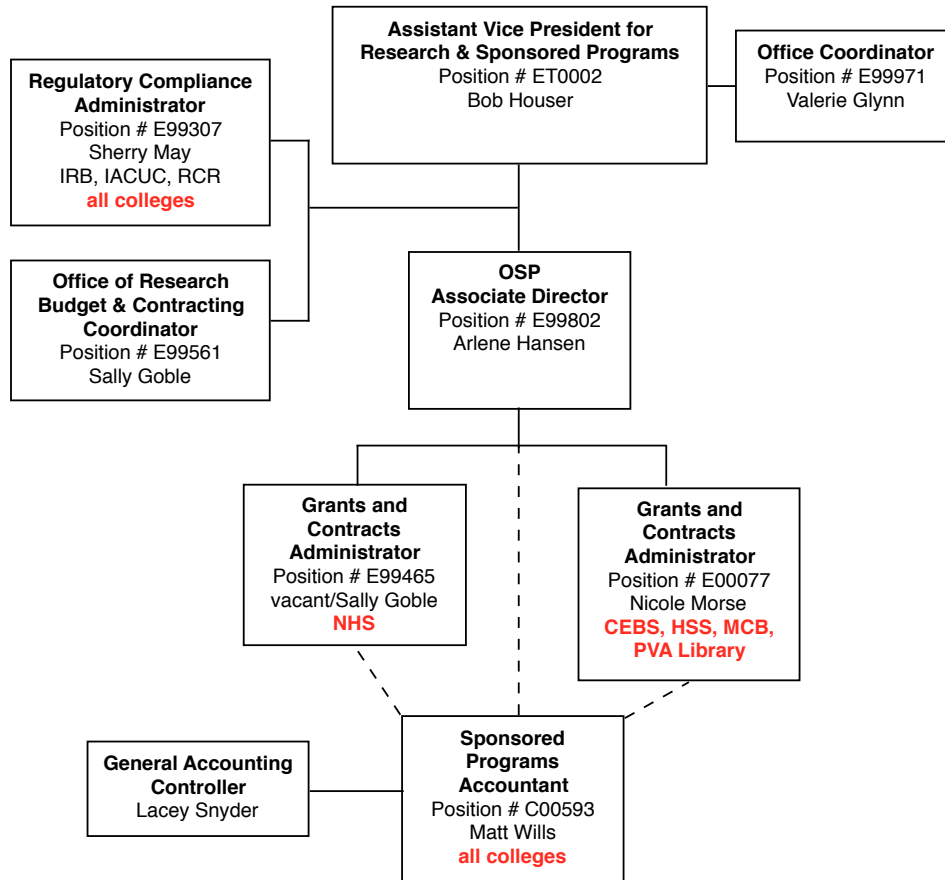
