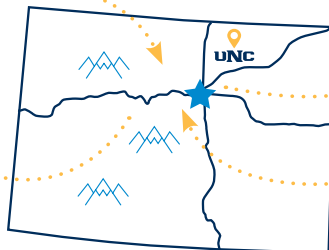
## UNC is Located

## FINANCIAL AID

UNC offers financial assistance through loans, grants, work-study and scholarships.

### FAFSA

**Every student should complete** the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is a required application for a wide range of financial aid, including need-based grants, loans, work-study and some UNC scholarships. For fall 2022 financial aid, you can fill out your FAFSA beginning October 1, 2021. You will use taxes from the 2020 tax year to complete your FAFSA for fall 2022.

### FOR FINANCIAL AID CONSIDERATION

- 1 Obtain a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) at [fsaid.ed.gov](https://fsaid.ed.gov). Complete the FAFSA at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov). UNC's school code is **001349**.
- 2 Admitted students who meet the requirements are automatically awarded the UNC scholarships listed below.
- 3 To be considered for other scholarships, submit the UNC Scholarship Application.
