



The UNC Sports Performance Department, located in the Empower Center, is accepting applications for the role of Graduate Assistant Sports Performance Coach beginning in Fall of 2024. The report date will be June 1, 2024.

Responsibilities: Under the guidance of the Sports Performance Staff, you will direct the training for 1-2 of UNC's varsity teams, assist with the implementation of performance programs for other teams as needed, and have supervision and direction of student interns. This is an in-person position job responsibilities cannot be completed remotely.

Qualifications: Acceptance into UNC's M.S. in Sports and Exercise Science program (application deadline February 1st). Ability to establish in-state tuition by Fall of 2024 or willingness to pay difference in tuition until residency is established. NSCA-CSCS certification and Certified in CPR/First Aid are required or in the process of completion upon arrival. One year of experience working in college athletics preferred.

Compensation: A tuition waiver is provided and a monthly stipend for 10 months each year.
