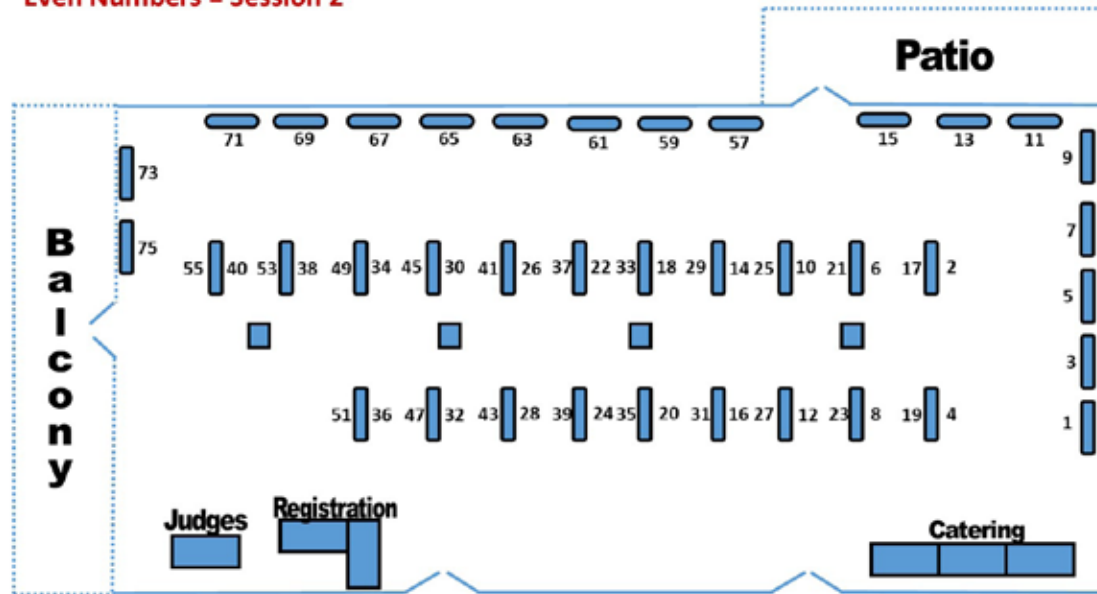

Even Numbers = Session 2

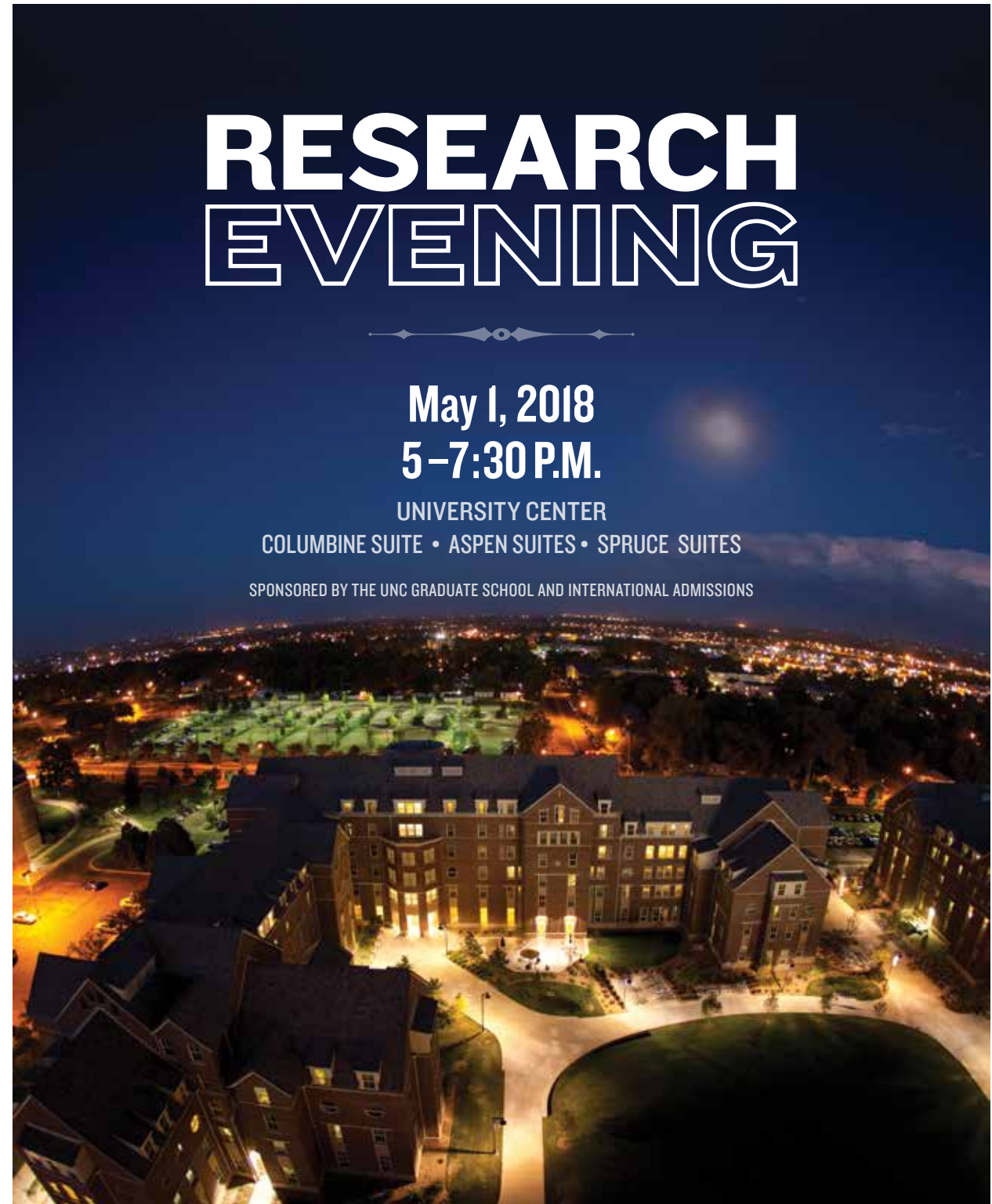
