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## Explanation of Enrollment Data

1. The Fall Final 2011 date is January 15, 2012. Data included in this report is information captured from the Banner System Tables.
2. Percent Change in this report is the measure of change from Fall Final 2010 to Fall Final 2011 as a percentage. Caution: When considering % change it is important to note that increases or decreases in categories with low numbers will result in a high percentage change.
3. Due to rounding, some graphs may not total 100%.
4. Urban Education students are included in Main Campus.
5. Colorado School of Public Health students are not included in this summary.
6. Funding Summary:
  - a. Headcount: Students counted in Extended Campus have only cash funded courses
  - b. Credit Hours: Main Campus and Extended Campus credit hours are determined by the accounting code assigned to the course.
7. Undergraduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 12 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 12 or more credit hours
8. Graduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 9 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 9 or more credit hours
9. Race/Ethnicity Categories adhere to the reporting standards as mandated by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB). [http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg\\_notice\\_15](http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg_notice_15)
10. Race/Ethnicity is self-reported by the student. Students may leave the question blank and cannot indicate "Do not wish to provide." Non US Citizens are students with a Visa.
11. First Generation is defined as a student who reported that neither parent/guardian graduated from a four-year college. Students that did not report are classified as Non-First Generation.
12. Low Income is defined as a student who is Pell Grant eligible. Statistics in this report reflect those students who were offered a Pell Grant greater than zero.
13. The Graduate Unclassified classification is students who are attending but have not yet been accepted into a Master's or Doctorate program or are non-degree seeking students.
14. Non-degree seeking graduate students are included in the Graduate School enrollment.

## Executive Summary

### Headcount by Classification (Page 5)

- The Fall Final total headcount of 13,038 is up by 8 students, which is a 0.1% increase from Fall Final 2010.
- Undergraduate headcount had a 0.5% decrease (50 students) from Fall Final 2010 while graduate headcount rose by 2.3% (58 students).
- Undergraduate freshmen decreased 6% (222 students) and sophomores decreased 5.2% (112 students) from Fall Final 2010.
- Freshmen classification is 33% of the undergraduate population.
- Graduate doctoral headcount increased by 30 students or 5.6% and unclassified graduate students decreased by 9 students.
- The number of graduate master's students increased by 2.1%, an increase of 30 students.
- 56% (1,470 of 2,624) of graduate students are pursuing a master's degree.

### Credit Hours by Classification (Page 6)

- The student credit hour total is 157,860, a 0.2% increase from Fall Final 2010.
- 89% (124,427 of 139,997) of undergraduate credit hours are resident and 78% (13,973 of 17,863) of graduate credit hours are resident. 88% (138,400 of 157,860) of the total student credit hours are resident.
- Although undergraduate headcount decreased by 0.5%, total credit hours increased 0.5%.
- While the graduate headcount increased 2.3%, total credit hours decreased 2.1% from Fall Final 2010.

### Funding Summary Headcount (Page 7)

- Undergraduate headcount for students with only Extended Campus courses declined by 25.9% (188 students) from Fall Final 2010.
- Graduate Extended Campus student headcount increased 13.6% or 140 students from Fall Final 2010.
- Overall, students with only Extended Campus courses fell 2.7% and represent 13.1% of the student population.

### Funding Summary Credit Hours (Page 8)

- Compared to Fall Final 2010, total Extended Campus credit hours decreased 7.7%, a decrease of 20.2% in undergraduate credit hours and an increase of 1.0% in graduate credit hours.
- Total Main Campus credit hours rose by 0.9% over Fall Final 2010.
- Main Campus credit hours (146,739) are 93.0% of the total (157,860).

### Course Load Summary (Page 9)

- The number of full-time undergraduates increased by 1%, while part-time decreased by 1% from Fall Final 2010.
- The number of full-time graduates decreased by 2%.

### Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 12)

- Approximately 22% of the undergraduate population identify with a minority classification, a 2% increase from Fall Final 2010.
- 13.3% of the total undergraduate population are Hispanic.
- Native American race/ethnicity decreased 8 students or 0.05%.

### **Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 13)**

- Approximately 12% of the undergraduate population identify with a minority classification, slightly higher than Fall Final 2010.
- 50 students or 1.9% identified as multi-racial.
- 5.8% of the total graduate population are Hispanic.

### **Undergraduate First Generation & Undergraduate Low Income (Page 14)**

Note: Low income is defined as students who have been offered a Pell Grant.

- 28% of the undergraduate population are first generation students.
- 33% of the undergraduate population are considered low income.

### **New Student Enrollment (Page 16)**

- New Freshmen increased 287 students or 12.5% from Fall Final 2010.
- There were 31 fewer transfer undergraduate students in Fall Final 2011 than Fall Final 2010.
- Graduate New Students increased 28.8% (109 students).
- Continuing graduate students declined 2.3% (51 students).

### **Students Enrolled in (at least one) Online Course (Page 17)**

- The percent of undergraduates enrolling in a least one online course remained constant at 18% from Fall Final 2010.
- Graduate students enrolling in at least online course increased 95 students to 37%.

### **Students enrolled by Gender (Page 18)**

- Females constitute 62% of the undergraduate population, which is constant from Fall Final 2010.
- 25% of Graduate students are male, down 2% from Fall Final 2010.

### **College Headcount (Page 20)**

- Generally, the enrollment among the colleges remains relatively stable.
- College of Natural & Health Sciences undergraduate headcount is down 382 (2,874 – 2,492) students from Fall Final 2010.
- College of Education & Behavioral Sciences undergraduate headcount increased 131 (1,022 – 1,153) students from Fall Final 2010.
- College of Performing & Visual Arts undergraduate and graduate headcount increased 36 students (17 undergraduate and 19 graduate).

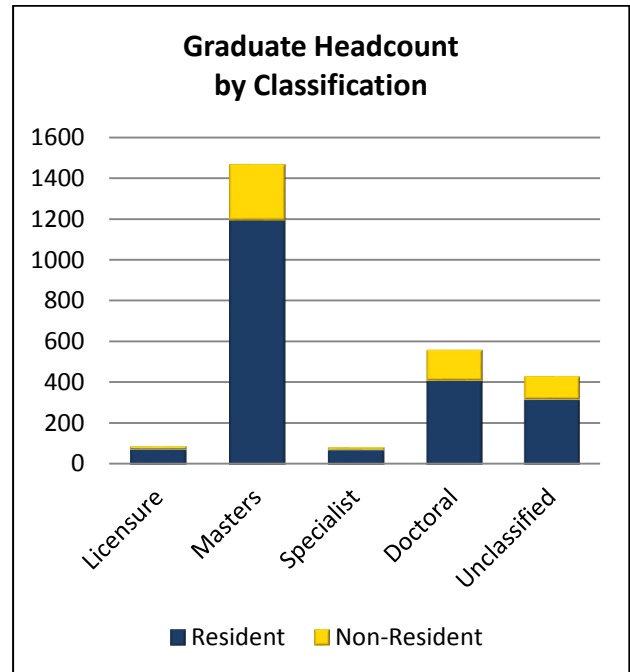
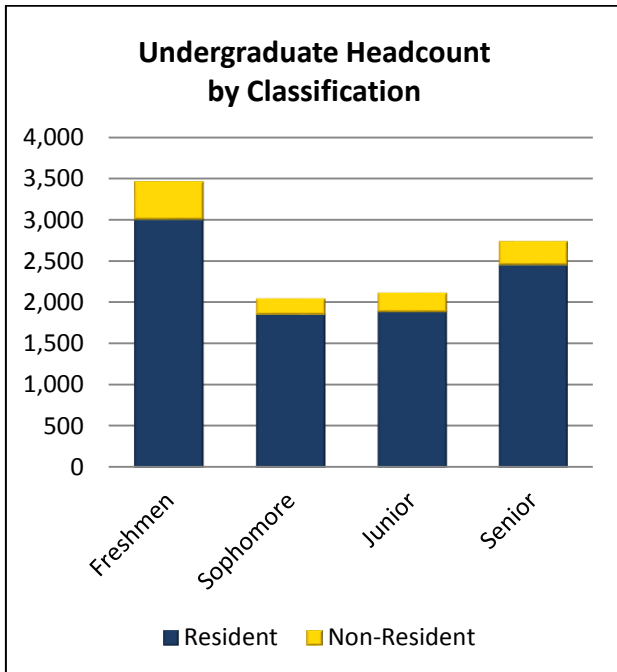
- 92% of new freshmen are 18 or 19 years old.
