## Explanation of Enrollment Data

1. The Spring Final date is June 10, 2012. Data included in this report is information captured from the Banner Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW).
2. Percent Change in this report is the measure of change from Spring Final 2011 to Spring Final 2012 as a percentage. Caution: When considering % change it is important to note that increases or decreases in categories with low numbers will result in a high percentage change.
3. Due to rounding, some graphs may not total 100%.
4. Urban Education students are included in Main Campus.
5. Colorado School of Public Health students are not included in this summary.
6. Funding Summary:
  - a. Headcount: Students counted in Extended Campus have only cash funded courses
  - b. Credit Hours: Main Campus and Extended Campus credit hours are determined by the accounting code assigned to the course.
7. Undergraduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 12 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 12 or more credit hours
8. Graduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 9 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 9 or more credit hours
9. Race/Ethnicity Categories adhere to the reporting standards as mandated by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB). [http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg\\_notice\\_15](http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg_notice_15)
10. Race/Ethnicity is self-reported by the student. Students may leave the question blank and cannot indicate "Do not wish to provide." Non US Citizens are students with a Visa.
11. First Generation is defined as a student who reported that neither parent/guardian graduated from a four-year college.
12. Low Income is defined as a student who is Pell Grant eligible. Statistics in this report reflect those students who were offered a Pell Grant greater than zero.
13. The Graduate Unclassified classification is students who are attending but have not yet been accepted into a Master's or Doctorate program or are non-degree seeking students.
14. Non-degree seeking graduate students are included in the Graduate School enrollment.

## Executive Summary

### Headcount by Classification (Page 5)

- The grand total Spring Final 2012 headcount of 12,190 is up from Spring Final 2011 by 343 students (2.9% increase).
- Undergraduate students increased 1.8% from Spring Final 2011, while Graduate students increased 7.3%.
- Undergraduate freshmen decreased 2.2 % (46 students) and sophomores decreased 7.9% (169 students) from Spring Final 2011.
- Senior classification is 30% of the undergraduate population.
- Graduate doctoral headcount increased by 53 students (10.5%) and master's graduate students increased by 30 students (2.2%).
- 55% (1,363 of 2,138) of graduate students are pursuing a master's degree.

### Credit Hours by Classification (Page 6)

- The student credit hour grand total is 143,983, a 0.4% increase from Spring Final 2011.
- 89% (113,055 of 127,582) of undergraduate credit hours are resident and 77% (12,635 of 16,401) of graduate credit hours are resident. 87% (125,690 of 143,983) of the total student credit hours are resident.
- Undergraduate headcount (Page 5) increased 1.8%, while credit hours rose only slightly (132 credit hours or 0.1%).
- Graduate headcount (Page 5) increased 7.3% and credit hours increased 2.7% from Spring Final 2011.

### Funding Summary Headcount (Page 7)

- Undergraduate headcount for students enrolled only in Extended Campus courses increased by 38.3% (189 students) from Spring Final 2011 while Main Campus headcount decreased 0.2% (17 students).
- 393 undergraduate students are part of the Western University Exchange (WUE).
- Graduate Extended Campus student headcount increased 24.1% or 210 students from Spring Final 2011.
- Graduate Main Campus headcount declined by 39 students or 2.6%.
- Overall, students with only Extended Campus courses rose 29.2% and represent 14.5% of the student population (1,764 of 12,190).

### Funding Summary Credit Hours (Page 8)

- Compared to Spring Final 2011, total Extended Campus credit hours increased 21.0%, an increase of 30.1% in undergraduate credit hours and 14.8% in graduate credit hours.
- Total Main Campus credit hours fell by 1% (1,398 credits) from Spring Final 2011.
- Main Campus credit hours (132,776) are 92.2% of the total (143,983).
- A very limited number of tuition-free credit hours (43) were courses taken by students under the Aims Cooperative Agreement, audited or by senior citizens.

### Course Load Summary (Page 9)

- Fewer undergraduate students were full-time in Spring Final 2012 compared to Spring Final 2011 (86% to 88%).
- 2% fewer graduate students are full-time for Spring Final 2012 compared to Spring Final 2011.

### Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 12)

- Approximately 21% of the undergraduate population identify with a minority classification compared to 19% for Spring Final 2011.

- 13.2% of the total undergraduate population are Hispanic.
- White population, as a percentage of the population, declined 10% going from 69.7% in Spring 2011 to 59.2% in Spring Final 2012.
- 18.9% of the students' ethnicity is unknown in Spring 2012 compared to 10.5% in Spring 2011.

#### **Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 13)**

- The percentage of minority graduate students increase to 13.9% from 11.2% the previous year.
- 6.3% of the total graduate student population are Hispanic compared to 4.4% in Spring Final 2011.

#### **Undergraduate First Generation & Undergraduate Low Income (Page 14)**

Note: Low income is defined as students who have been offered a Pell Grant.

- 34% have self-reported as first generation undergraduate students compared to 22% in Spring 2011.
- The percentage of undergraduate low income students has remained fairly constant. 31% of the undergraduate population are considered low income.

#### **New Student Enrollment (Page 16)**

- The number of New Freshmen decrease to 62 students compared to 85 in Spring 2011.
- There were 30 more undergraduate New Transfer students in Spring Final 2012 than 2011.
- The number of graduate New Students increased by 304 students from 2011, while continuing graduate students decreased by 133.

#### **Students Enrolled in (at least one) Online Course (Page 17)**

- The percent of undergraduates enrolled in a least one on-line course increased 1% from Spring Final 2011.
- The percentage of graduate students enrolled in at least one online course increased 6% from Spring Final 2011.
- 38% of all graduate students took an online class.

#### **Students enrolled by Gender (Page 18)**

- Females constitute 62% of the undergraduate population, the same percentage as Spring Final 2011.
- 25% of Graduate students are male, down 2% from Spring Final 2011.

#### **College Headcount (Page 20)**

- The College of Natural & Health Sciences undergraduate headcount is down 398 (2,351 – 2,749) students from Spring Final 2011.
- College of Education & Behavioral Sciences undergraduate headcount increased 76 (1,045 - 969) students from Spring Final 2011.
- 50% of the graduate students are enrolled in the College of Education & Behavioral Sciences.

#### **Age (Page 22)**

- 68.7% of all undergraduate students are 24 years old or younger and 19.5% are 25 to 29 years old.
- 58.6% of all graduate students are 30 years old or older.

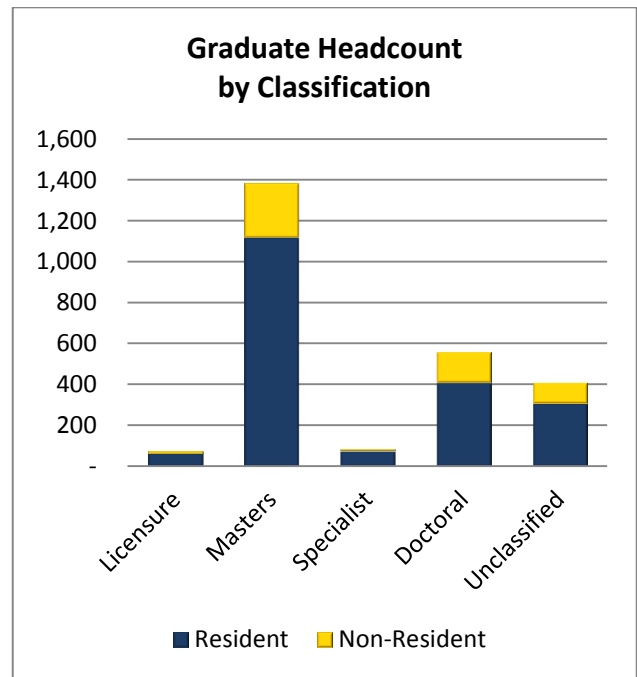
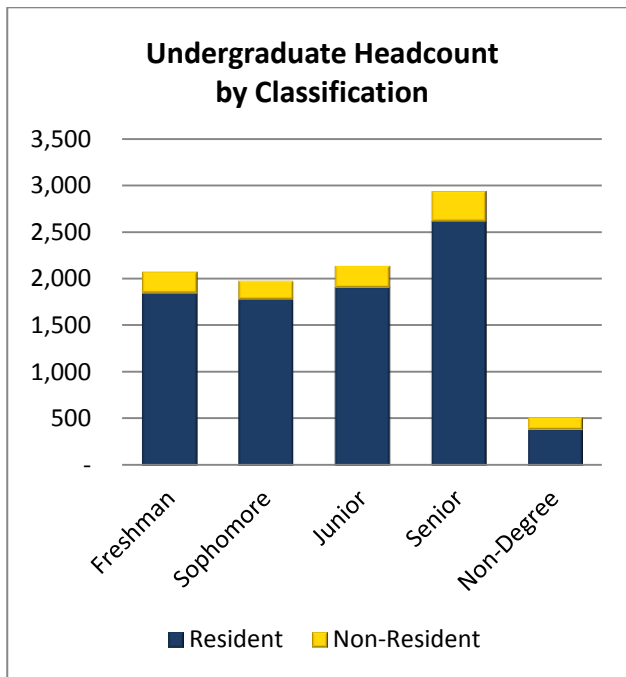
#### **Commencement (Page 24)**
