## Explanation of Enrollment Data

1. The Spring Final date is May 20, 2013. Data included in this report is information captured from the Banner Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW).
2. Percent Change in this report is the measure of change from Spring Final 2012 to Spring Final 2013 as a percentage. Caution: When considering % change it is important to note that increases or decreases in categories with low numbers will result in a high percentage change.
3. Due to rounding, some graphs may not total 100%.
4. Urban Education students are included in Main Campus.
5. Colorado School of Public Health students are not included in this summary.
6. Funding Summary:
  - a. Headcount: Students counted in Extended Campus have only cash funded courses
  - b. Credit Hours: Main Campus and Extended Campus credit hours are determined by the accounting code assigned to the course.
7. Undergraduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 12 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 12 or more credit hours
8. Graduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 9 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 9 or more credit hours
9. Race/Ethnicity Categories adhere to the reporting standards as mandated by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB). [http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg\\_notice\\_15](http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg_notice_15)
10. Race/Ethnicity is self-reported by the student. Students may leave the question blank and cannot indicate "Do not wish to provide." Non US Citizens are students with a Visa.
11. First Generation is defined as a student who reported that neither parent/guardian graduated from a four-year college.
12. Low Income is defined as a student who is Pell Grant eligible. Statistics in this report reflect those students who were offered a Pell Grant greater than zero.
13. The Graduate Unclassified classification is students who are attending but have not yet been accepted into a Master's or Doctorate program or non-degree seeking students.
14. Non-degree seeking graduate students are included in the Graduate School enrollment.
15. High School Undergraduates are enrolled students who are age 18 or younger and have not graduated high school or earned a GED.
16. New First-time students are not high school undergraduates nor are they Study Abroad, zero credit hour students. New First-Time students are those students who are enrolled in Spring as their first term.
17. New Transfer Students are undergraduate students who are enrolled in Spring as their first at the undergraduate level and has earned college credit(s) at another institution.
18. Freshmen classification are undergraduate students with 0-29 credits; Sophomore classification includes students with 30-59 credits; Juniors have 60-89 credits and Seniors have 90 or more credits until completion of a bachelor's degree.
19. Fall to Spring retention by classification reflects the student's class at the beginning of the fall term.

## Executive Summary

### Headcount by Classification (Page 6)

- The total university Spring Final 2013 headcount of 12,252 is up by 62 students which is a 0.5% increase from Spring Final 2012.
- Undergraduate headcount decreased by 5 students (-0.1%) from Spring Final 2012 while graduate student headcount increased 67 students or 2.7%.
- Senior classification is 31.8% of the undergraduate population compared to 30.4% at Spring Final 2012.
- Graduate Licensure headcount increased by 30 students (39.5%).
- The number of graduate Masters students decreased by 11 or -0.8%. Masters students represent 53% of those at the graduate level compared to 55% in Spring 2012.
- Undergraduate resident students are 86.6% of all undergraduates and 74.1% of all graduate students are resident students.

### Credit Hours by Classification (Page 7)

- The student credit hour grand total is 142,903 and -0.8% decrease from Spring Final 2012.
- The majority (87.5%) of the total student credit hours are resident (122,473); 87.5% of undergraduate credit hours are resident and 72% of graduate credit hours are resident.
- Undergraduate headcount (see Table Headcount by Classification) decreased by -0.1% while undergraduate credit hours decreased by -0.9%.
- The graduate headcount increased 2.7%, and the graduate Spring Final credit hours increased by 0.8% (+125 credits).
- The Graduate Licensure headcount went up 39.5% and the credit hours also increased by 43.7%.

### Funding Summary Headcount (Page 8)

- Main Campus headcount is 84.5% of the total.
- Undergraduate WUE headcount increased 37% or 144 students.
- Undergraduate headcount for students registered in extended campus courses increased by 5.7% (+39) and Main campus headcount declined -0.49% or -44 enrollees.
- Graduate Extended Campus headcount increased 9.1% from Spring Final 2012 while Main Campus decreased by -2.2%.

### Funding Summary Credit Hours (Page 9)

- Main Campus credit hours (131,439) are 92% of the total 142,903. The percentage in Spring 2012 was 92.2% of the total credits.
- The undergraduate main campus credit hours differ -1.0% from Spring Final 2012.
- Spring Final 2013 WUE credit hours are 5.2% of the total undergraduate credit hours.
- Graduate main campus hours decreased -151 hours or -1.5% compared to Spring Final 2012.
- The total Main campus credit hours decreased by -1,337 credit hours, a -1.0% decrease from Spring Final 2012, while the Extended campus increased by 2.2% or 242 credit hours.

### Course Load Summary (Page 10)

- The percentage change of undergraduate part-time students increased by 1%. The percentage change of graduate students who are full-time declined -5.3% from Spring Final 2012 (51 students).

### **Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 13)**

- Approximately 23% of the undergraduate population is minority this is an increase over Spring Final 2012 (21%).
- Within the minority category, the Hispanic classification is the largest and represents 15% of the entire undergraduate population. The Hispanic classification was 13.2% of the total undergraduate population at Spring Final 2012.
- Undergraduate African American students increased 2.3% from Spring 2012 Final (+8 students).
- Undergraduate Asian students decreased -10.3% from Spring 2012 Final (-16 students).
- White students are 59.8% of the undergraduate population compared to 59.2% in Spring 2012 which is an increase of 51 students.

### **Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 14)**

- The graduate minority population decreased from 13.9% to 13.3% in Spring 2013 Final.
- Hispanic graduate students represent 6.7% of the total graduate population increasing from 6.3% at Spring Final 2012.
- Non-US Citizen headcount increased by 121 students which is a 233% increase over Spring 2012 Final.
- Asian students decreased by -32.5% (-26 student) as well as, Native American students (-30.8%) or -4 students from Spring 2012 Final.

### **Undergraduate First Generation & Undergraduate Low Income (Page 15)**

- Low income is defined as those students who are Pell Grant Eligible.
- The percentage change of first generation students has remained the same as Spring final 2012 (34%).
- Low income undergraduate students are 32.4% of all undergraduate students vs. 31.3% in Spring 2012.

### **Undergraduate First Generation and Low Income (Page 16)**

- The percentage of undergraduate students that are both first generation and low income increased 1% in Spring 2013 from 16% up to 17%.

### **New Student Enrollment (Page 17)**

- The number of degree-seeking new transfer undergraduate students decreased -15.4% (-54 students) from Spring 2012.
- The number of degree-seeking new first-time undergraduate students decreased -9.4% going from 64 students in 2012 down to 58 in 2013.
- New First Time degree-seeking graduate student realized a 28.4% change (33 students) when compared to Spring Final 2012. New First Time non-degree-seeking graduate students also increased by 7.3% or 22 students.

### **Students Enrolled in (at least one) Online Course (Page 18)**

- The percentage of undergraduate students enrolling in (at least) one online course changed from 22% in Spring 2012 to 24%.
- The percentage of graduate students enrolling in (at least) online course increased from 38% of the graduate population to 39%.

### **Students enrolled by Gender (Page 19)**

- The percentage of undergraduate females remained constant from Spring Final 2012 (62%). The percent change of graduate males increased to 1% over Spring Final 2012.

#### **College Headcount (Page 21)**

- The College of Natural & Health Sciences (NHS) undergraduate headcount is up 24.1% from Spring Final 2012 (566 students) which is 30% of the undergraduate total headcount of 9,225
- College of Education & Behavioral Sciences (EBS) undergraduate headcount increased 55 students (5.3%) from Spring Final 2012. EBS graduate student headcount also increased 25 students or 2.0% from Spring Final 2012.
- The College of Performing & Visual Arts undergraduate headcount increased 46 students (5.9%) while the graduate headcount for PVA decreased -8 students.
- The College of Humanities and Social Sciences (HSS) undergraduate headcount decreased -14 students (-0.7%).
- Monfort College of Business undergraduate headcount increased 6.6% or 54 students
- University College decreased by -15.4% (-251 students) compared to Spring Final 2012
- Non-Degree Seeking undergraduate students decreased by -42.6% (-461 students).
- Graduate School increased by 9.7% (40 students) when compared to Spring Final 2012.

#### **College Credit Hours (Page 22)**

- Undergraduate credit hours are up in the College of Performing & Visual Arts and the College of Natural & Health Sciences 7.7% and 22.9% respectively.
- The College of Humanities and Social Sciences undergraduate credit hours decreased -1.07% and University College decreased by -14.93%.
- Graduate credit hours are down -4.46% in PVA compared to Spring 2012.
- Graduate credit hours are up in MCB 5.19% or 7 credit hours.
- Graduate School credit hours increased by 6.10% compared to Spring Fall 2012.
- EBS graduate credits increased by 0.83%.

#### **Age Summary (Page 23)**

- 86.5 percent of undergraduate students are under the age of 25.
- 18% of graduate students are 45 years old or older.

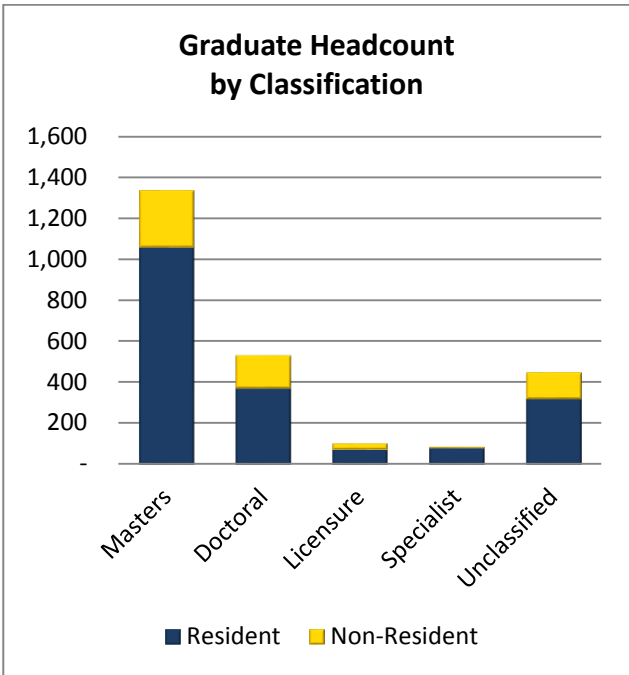
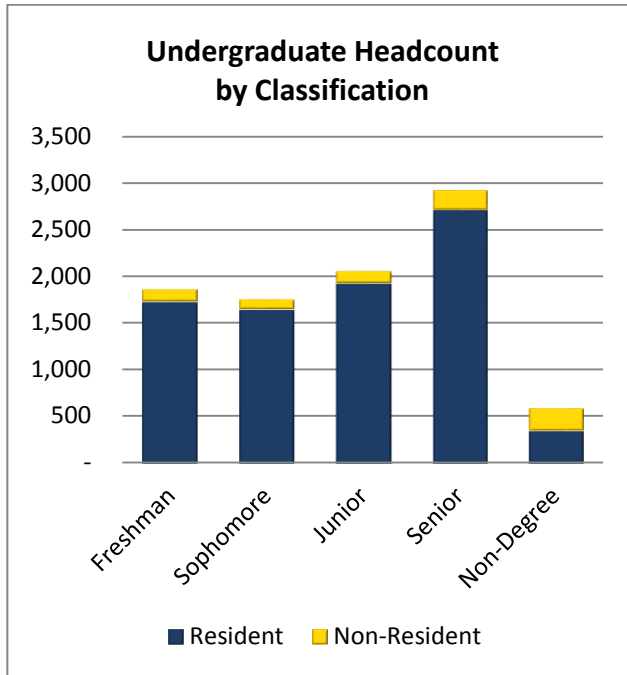
#### **Fall to Spring Undergraduate Retention (Page 24)**
