

Foreign Language Placement

Students are encouraged to discuss their background in language study and their confidence level with appropriate faculty advisors. Foreign language advisors are available in the College of Humanities and Social Sciences.

Guidelines for Placement in Spanish Courses:

- Students who want to take Spanish are encouraged to take a placement test.
- If students have AP credits, they do not need to take the placement exam. Consult with a foreign language advisor on class placement.

Guidelines for Placement in French and German Courses:

- There are not placement tests for the other languages.

101 = for students with 0 to 1 year of comparable high school foreign language

102 = for students with 2 years of comparable high school foreign language

201 = for students with 3 years of comparable high school foreign language

202 = for students with 4 or more years of comparable high school foreign language
