Academic Advisor Name

- Click on the "Student" Tab
- Look for the "Academic Profile" box
- If you are declared and there isn't an advisor listed, call your department to have an advisor assigned.
- If you are undeclared, your advisor is located in Academic Support and Advising.

Your Transcript

- You can see all classes that have been taken at UNC, classes transferred to UNC, GPA each semester, and cumulative (overall) GPA.
- Click on the "Student" Tab
- Look for the "Important Links" box
- Click "Unofficial Transcript"
- Click "Submit"

Your Grades

- Click on the "Student" Tab
- Look for the "Student Grades" box
- Select Term from drop down menu
- Click "Go"
- Once grades have been submitted by your professors, they will be listed on this screen.

Registration for Classes

- Click on the “Student” Tab
- Look for the “Registration Tools” box
- Click “Schedule of Classes”
- Select the term for registration
- Click “Submit”
- Start searching for desired courses

Pay Your UNC Bill

- Click on the “Financial” Tab
- Look for the “My Account” box
- Balance listed
- A small credit card symbol is next to the balance for easy payment. Click it and follow directions

Degree Evaluation/ What-If Analysis

- The Degree Evaluation lists all classes that have been taken at UNC, as well as classes transferred to UNC. It shows how classes count toward graduation (Liberal Arts Core, major, minor, or electives.)
- The What-If Analysis allows you to run a Degree Evaluation for a different major. This is helpful if you are thinking about changing your major and you are wondering how classes taken fit into a new major.
- Click on the “Student” Tab
- Look for the “Graduation” box
- Click “Degree Evaluation”
- Scroll to bottom of page and select “What-if Analysis” link or “Generate New Evaluation” link
- Select term (usually the next semester)
- Under “Program” select desired major from drop down menu
- Click “Continue”
- Under “First Major” select desired major program from drop down menu
- Click “Submit”
- Select term
- Click “Generate Request”
- Select “Detail Requirements” and click submit
- Requirements for new major will be listed (LAC, major, minor, electives, etc.)

Class Registration Holds

- Click on the “Student” Tab
- Look for the “Registration Tools” box
- Click “Registration Status”
- Select Term and click submit
- At the bottom of page, select “View Holds” link
- Any holds on your account will be listed. Go to the designated office to get the hold removed.

GPA Prediction

- Click on the “Student” Tab
- Look for the “GPA Prediction” box
- Select estimated grade for each class
- Estimated GPA will appear at the bottom of the screen
