

## DRAFT POLICY

### Awarding course credit for completion of an International Baccalaureate Diploma or Certificate

1. UNC will award credit only in the subject areas in which UNC offers undergraduate courses.
2. To receive credit in a subject area a student must achieve a score of 4 (satisfactory) or higher. No credit will be awarded for scores less than 4.
3. Students completing the standard level curriculum in a subject area, and achieving a subject area score of 4 or higher, will be awarded at least 3 credit hours in the discipline. Course credit hours awarded for completion of the standard level curriculum will fulfill General Education requirements where possible.
4. Students completing the higher-level curriculum in a subject area, and achieving a score of 4 or higher, will be awarded the same credits as those awarded at the standard level and will also be awarded at least 3 additional credit hours in the discipline.
