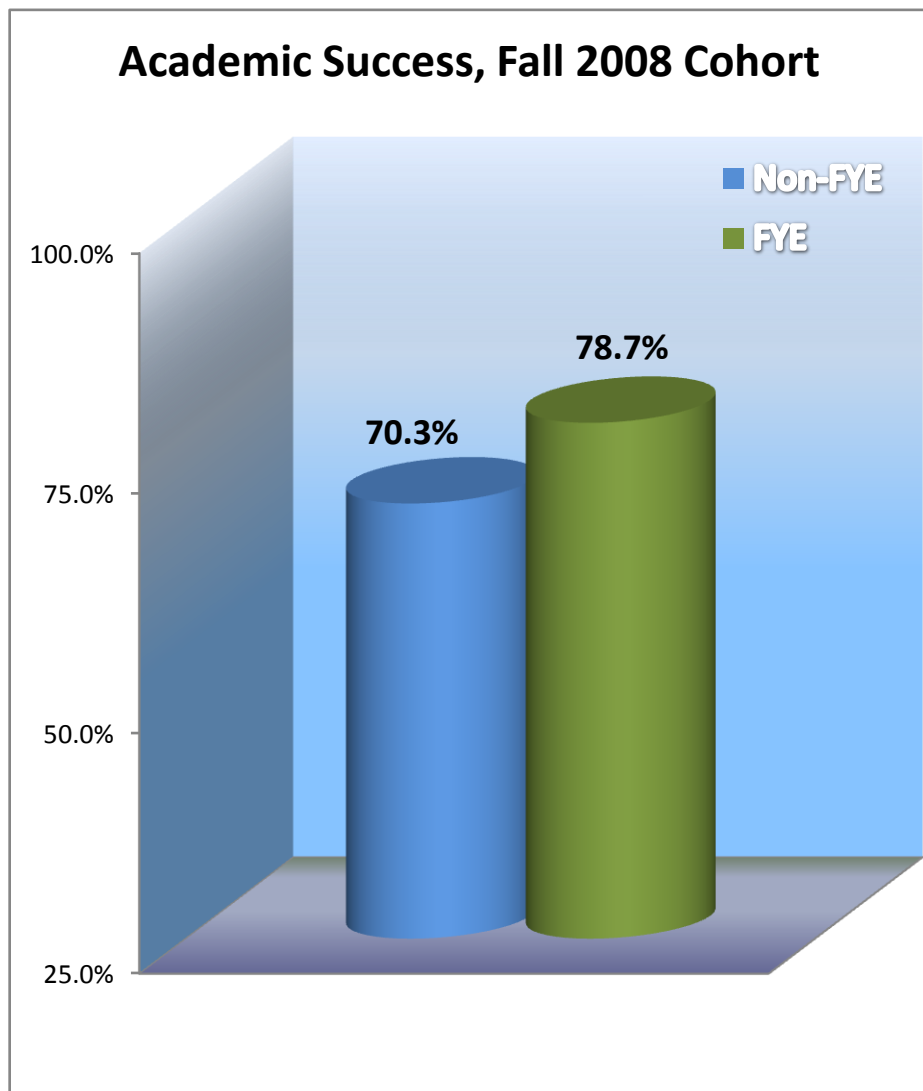


## UNC's FYE 108 Course and Academic Success, 2008-2009

An important threshold at UNC is a 2.0 grade point average (GPA). If a student maintains a GPA over 2.0, they are considered to be in good academic standing with UNC. When a student falls under this threshold, it can be difficult to succeed at the



university and to achieve one's goals at the university and beyond.

Our program evaluation data from the 2008-2009 academic year suggests that UNC's FYE 108 course impacts academic success by helping students stay in good academic standing at UNC. Students enrolled in the course stayed off of academic probation at a 8.4% higher rate as compared to their non-enrolled peers. In practice, if all 2083 first year students took UNC's FYE 108 course, we could help 174 students stay in good academic standing, and have a higher probability of

graduating from UNC. By addressing areas of a student's development integral to competent scholarship, the FYE 108 course strives to impact student success at UNC.
