- 3. Announcements and Updates
 - ILO Project Update Cohort 1 have all resigned. Aaron explained that Kathy Zellers is in the process of loading the learning outcomes and rubrics into Canvas shells. The second cohort is going now and is being fast-tracked to completion in order to do their assessment in the Spring. We had 3 programs apply this year—The English Writing Program, the Chicano/a and LatinX program, and GOAL Program.

assessment grants; the third would be to go back to the applications that were declined last year. We would still have funds left and could open up the application process to award two additional traditional grants. After discussion, it was agreed that it would not be prudent to add any new programs to the ILO Project at this point. It was agreed that the two programs who were turned down should be contacted and offered the opportunity to go forward with their proposed project.
