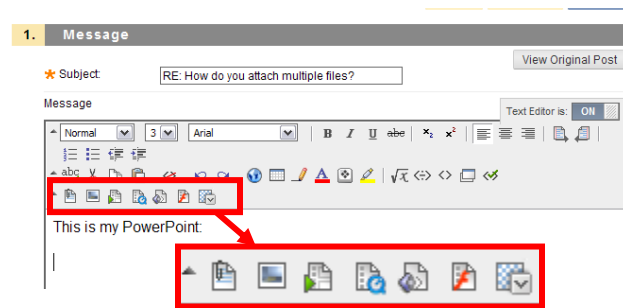
Introduction

You can add a YouTube video into a discussion posting, or a blog, journal or wiki.

The **Add Mashup, YouTube Video** tool in the text editor let's you search YouTube for videos and insert them into your postings.

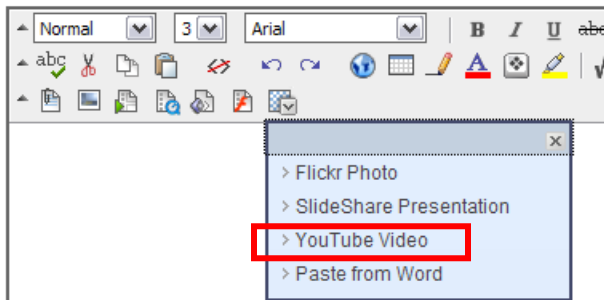
Adding a YouTube Video

The text editor has a new tool to called **Add Mashup** and lets you insert a YouTube video, photo from Flickr or slide show from SlideShare into a posting.



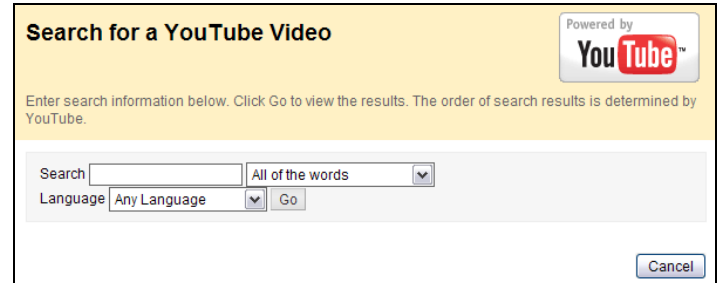
Add Mashup Tool

1. Position the cursor in your posting.
2. In the text editor box, click the **Add Mashup Tool**.
3. The following options display.

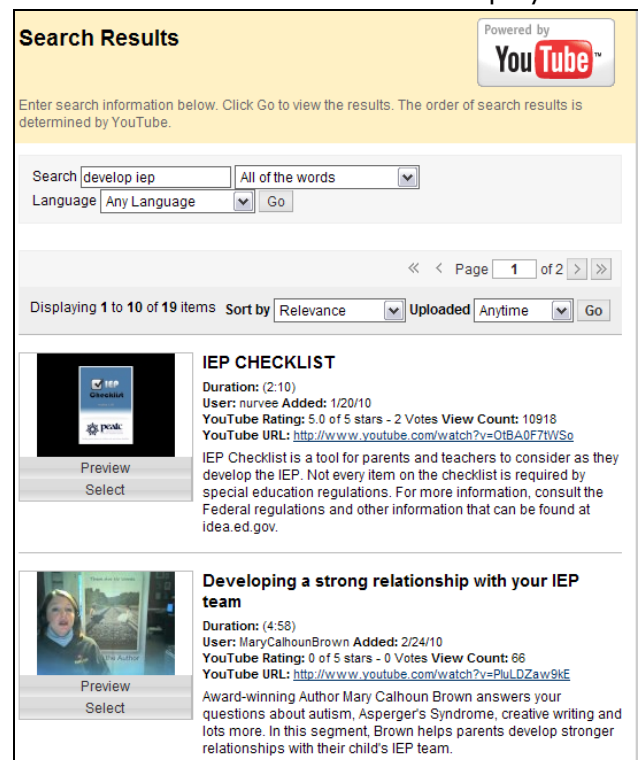


4. Select **YouTube Video**.

5. A pop up box appears:



6. Type a search phrase in the Search box.
7. Notice that the drop down menu has the following choices:
 - All of the words
 - At least one of the words
 - Without the words
 - Exact phrase
8. Click **Go** to start the search.
9. Videos from YouTube will be displayed:



Add YouTube to Postings



2. Mashup Options

Show YouTube URL creates a link to the YouTube web site enabling students to browse videos. Show YouTube information displays length of video, name of creator and the date video was added.
