PERMISSION FOR NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION – CAMP STOCK

Summer Enrichment Program supplies some non-prescription medications for your child's use if it is determined necessary by the program staff and has been approved by the SEP medical director. According to the Colorado Department of Health standards of practice, we need your permission to use any non-prescription medicines for your child. The non-prescription medications that are available in the program office are listed below:

Acetaminophen/Tylenol (non aspirin for pain relief, fever)

Advil/Motrin/Ibuprofen (pain relief & fever)

Alcohol (cleansing)

Anbesol (toothaches, mouth soreness, etc.)

Antibiotic Ointment (infected sores, scrapes)

Athletes Foot Spray/Cream (athlete's foot)

Bee Sting Swabs

Benadryl liquid and/or tablets (allergic reaction relief)

Bug Spray/lotion (help in prevention of insect bites on body)

Caladryl Lotion (skin rashes, insect bites)

Cortisone Ointment 1% (itching, rashes)

Cough Syrup and Lozenges (Robitussin & Halls) (persistent cough)

Saline eye wash (eye irritation)

Hydrogen Peroxide (cleaning)

Insta-Glucose/Cake Mate Gel (insulin reaction in diabetes)

Mylanta II Chew tabs or liquid, Antacid (stomach)

Sudafed (common cold)

Sun block Lotion (to help prevent sunburn)

Vaseline (dry lips, skin)
