### Colorado Rural (Student) Teacher Stipend for Fall 2023

Apply by March 31, 2023.

The Colorado Center for Rural Education and the Colorado Department of Higher Education encourage talented teacher candidates to student teach in Colorado rural school districts and eventually become a teacher in a Colorado rural school district. The value of the stipend is up to \$4,000 for the semester of student teaching.
