



Tobacco-related death is the leading cause of preventable death in the United States. Each year over 400,000 people die from tobacco-related causes, including 50,000 people who have never used tobacco. The primary goals of the Tobacco-Free UNC initiative are to 1) eliminate exposure to secondhand smoke and tobacco use in general, which is known to cause cancer, and 2) to aid tobacco users who want to quit with on-campus and off-campus resources.
