



GETTING TO THE UNIVERSITY CENTER AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN COLORADO

Both US Highways 34 (east-west) and 85 (north-south) travel through Greeley. Interstate 25 is about 10 miles to the west, Interstate 70 is about 55 miles to the south, and Interstate 76 runs at a diagonal leading from Denver to the north-east corner of Colorado, passing about 20 miles south of Greeley at its closest.

If you wish to use Google Maps or MapQuest on the internet, the address for the University Center is 2045 10th Avenue, Greeley, Colorado. In Greeley, the majority of the streets are number sequentially. The “Avenues” run north-south and the “Streets” run east-west.

From Denver (goes to Loveland turnoff)

- On Interstate 25, take exit 257A, turn right (east) onto US-34.
- Keep going east on US 34 until you get into Greeley. Do not take the Business 34 exit that goes over the bridge.
- You will go through several stoplights.
- Turn left on 11th avenue
- Turn right on 20th Street at the top of a hill. To the right is the University Center with a bronze bear in front.
- Park in the north or south lot on the block where the University Center is located for free. Parking in other lots on campus is allowed if you purchase a daily permit for \$3.50 at the machines located at the entrance to the lots.
