Students who receive sanctions as a result of an informal hearing in the Dean of Students Office, *other than* suspension, expulsion, or loss of recognition, have the right to appeal the decision and/or sanctions.

Students may choose to appeal the decision based on one or more of the following:

1. Due process was denied (you believe the Hearing Officer violated your student rights/ responsibilities or didn't follow the written conduct process/procedures).
2. Presence of new information. The presentation of the new information that was not available at the time of the hearing must be considered sufficiently substantial to change the outcome in a significant manner.
3. The sanctions given were inappropriate given the nature of the violation.

The appeal will be based on the hearing record and the facts of the case. The appeal process will not be a rehearing of the case. The written appeal is reviewed by an appeal reader, appointed by the Dean of Students and he or she may affirm or reverse the decision, or remand the case to another Hearing Officer for further deliberation.
