- For Liberal Arts Core category 3a, take HUM 130;
- For Liberal Arts Core category 3b, take ENG 131, ENG 211, ENG 213, ENG 214, ENG 236, or ENG 262;
- For Liberal Arts Core category 8, take ENG 236.
