Like all English majors, first- and second-year English education students should be directed to complete General Education courses, as well as all 200-level and some 300-level English courses. Please note the following recommendations:

- Take ENG 225 rather than ENG 123 for General education category 1b;
- For General Education category 4d, take ENG 131, ENG 211, ENG 213, or ENG 214;
- For General Education category 7a, take HUM 130;
- For General Education category 7b, take ENG 236;
- ENG 303 or ENG 319 **only** fulfill the writing requirement (not ENG 340);
- ENG 318 should be taken before ENG 419.
