Unfinished Business

- Out-of-state remote work policy
 - o Parks Nothing to move forward at this time.

• Compensation Identity update

- The committee reviewed NCHEMS Comparison Group Selection Service methodology.
 - Examine selection criteria and whether it's weighted appropriately
- Part 1: Selection Criteria
 - Public 4-year, no land grant institutions, no medical schools, and similar Carnegie Classification
- Part 2: Weighting Criteria
 - The means by which to rank institutions from most similar to most dissimilar
 - Range for each variable
 - Weight/importance for each variable
 - Weighting criteria include student FTE, research expenditures, percent of UG students awarded Pell grants, and several other criteria.
 - The lower an institution's score, the more similar an institution is to UNC.
- o Part 3: Final Adjustments
 - Institutions can be included or excluded based on other factors outside the selection and weighting criteria.
 - Using the selection and weighting criteria outlined in the document, an initial list of 82 peer institutions was generated.
- Parks is meeting with NCHEMS on Tuesday to discuss next steps forward.

DISCUSSION:

- How to incorporate cost of living analysis
 - Maybe calculate on our own after the peer group is identified
- Weighting criteria: ranges and importance, what other factors to consider
 - Maybe include performing/visual arts degrees, first-generation student population, and endowment size if those options are available
- Parks will ask NCHEMS representatives to meet with us next time.

• Adjunct/Overload pay rates

- o Greene sent a draft to the President and Provost for their initial review and feedback.
 - Greene will meet with Provost Anderson tomorrow for further discussion.
- o MFA/terminal degree will be included on the PhD line of the credential chart.
- o There may be some issues with how faculty are paid through Extended Campus.
 - Invite the Extended Campus Director to a future meeting when we are ready to discuss issues relating to Extended Campus.
