



INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

The University of Northern Colorado is pleased to announce the INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP. Recipients will receive \$5,000 each year for a maximum of four years of undergraduate studies at UNC.

This award is open to students applying to enter their freshman year at UNC as well as to students transferring from another post-secondary institution. Maximum eligibility for transfer students will be

- 6 semesters for students entering UNC at the sophomore level
- 4 semesters for students entering UNC at the junior level
- 2 semesters for students entering UNC at the senior level

Applicants will submit no later than May 1 (transfer students, June 15) for the following academic year

1. A minimum TOEFL score of 520 pbt, 190 cbt or 70 ibt
2. A gpa of 3.0 when converted to an American grading scale
3. Two letters of recommendation from instructors at their current high school, university or other post secondary institution
4. A one page essay discussing "How my degree from the University of Northern Colorado will Contribute to My Life Goals"

Recipients will be selected by a committee comprised of representatives from

- UNC faculty
- International Admissions
- Intensive English Language Programs
- Center for International Education

Recipients of the INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP must be enrolled full time each semester (a minimum of 12 credits) and must maintain a minimum gpa of 3.0 in order to continue their awards. (Coursework in Intensive English will not be recognized as part of the required 12 credits.)
