Nearly 600 students at the University of Northern Colorado are part of the Greek Life system. With 22 different fraternities and sororities, Greek Life adds a dimension to college that cannot be found in other organizations. For some, it serves as a support network and a place to develop friendships. For others, it is a chance to become involved in community service, philanthropy projects, leadership opportunities, and academic pursuits. LEADERSHIP

Sorority and fraternity members are offered a variety of leadership opportunities and programs in which they can develop skills such as time management, team work, accountability, and communication. The governing bodies of the Greek system, which include the Panhellenic Council, Interfraternity Council (IFC), and Multicultural Greek Council (MGC) all work together with each organization to promote these leadership activities and opportunities. Several sorority and fraternity members hold positions either within the councils, their organizations, or in other major student groups on campus.

FUN GREEK FACTS

Only 2% of the population of the United States is a member of a fraternity or sorority. However, this percentage is a powerful group of individuals...

- Over 85% of student leaders on more than 700 campuses are involved in sorority and fraternity life.
- Since 1825, when the first fraternity was founded, all but eight U.S. Presidents have been fraternity members.
- Of the nation's 50 largest corporations, 43 are led by fraternity men and/or sorority women.
- Students involved in a Greek organization have a higher graduation rate than those who are not.
- Greeks develop relationships with alumni that can assist them when looking for a job or advice after graduating.
