



University Honors Program Verification of Thesis/Capstone Presentation

In partial fulfillment of Hon 451: Senior Honors Research Capstone, all students are required to present their thesis/capstone in a public forum. The capstone presentation is not an oral defense. Rather, it is a chance for students to gain presentation experience and share their research findings with people interested in their work.

Students are allowed to present in any appropriate venue, but most students present at UNC's Research Day or Works in Progress Symposium. Students may invite faculty, family, and friends to attend their presentation. Invitations to the presentation should be extended to the Thesis/Capstone Advisor, Honors Advisor, and Center for HSL Director well in advance of the date of the presentation.
