



University Honors Program Verification of Community or Professional Engagement

As a means of developing a personal ethic or professional demeanor in one's field or discipline, each student in the University Honors Program must provide evidence of participation in one of the following while enrolled at UNC:

- ✓ a leadership role in a campus student organization.
- ✓ a peer mentor role for Honors or another campus organization.
- ✓ a volunteer coordinator for a campus-wide or community-wide event or activity.
- ✓ participation in NCHC or other professional organization conference.
- ✓ membership or affiliation with a discipline-based professional organization.

This requirement became effective with the 2006-2007 UNC Catalog, and all Honors students admitted to UNC beginning in Fall 2006 are subject to this requirement.
