



Things To Review in Your Migrated Course



Quizzes

Tests, surveys, and pools migrate as Quizzes and Question Banks. Some question types will not migrate. Some quizzes may need to be rebuilt from the Question Bank. Spend time working on your quizzes.



Pages

Each item in Blackboard will become a page in Canvas. The pages can be found in your Modules and Pages menu. Unwanted pages can only be deleted from this menu.



Assignments

All graded items show on the Assignments page organized by group (Assignments, Quizzes, Discussions). Delete unwanted assignment groups. Move assignments into the organization that makes sense for your course.



Discussions

Discussions migrate and include the instructions and grading options. Discussions can be “pinned” so they stay at the top of the discussion page. Other discussions will be in the order of most recent activity.



Syllabus

The syllabus content will be located in your modules. Delete the module and upload your new syllabus to the Canvas Syllabus menu.



Announcements

Delete unwanted announcements or edit them to include release dates.



Modules

All menus in Blackboard will become modules in Canvas. The modules will be organized in the same order you used in Blackboard. Add/remove content in each module to reflect your course organization.



Menu

Canvas has a standard menu. You can hide sections to streamline the menu of your course by going to the course Settings > Navigation tab.



Vericite (Plagiarism Tool)

Assignments that previously used SafeAssign will need to be set-up to use Vericite. Vericite includes UNC's institutional data that was collected in SafeAssign.



Audio/Video Mashup

If you used Mashup tools in Blackboard, they will not migrate. Videos and audio items that were embedded using embed codes will. Double-check to make sure all links work.



Files

If you had items with multiple attachments and/or folders within folders, some content might not be attached to a Page. If this is the case, check the Files system in Canvas: the files may be in the course and can then be reinserted in the Page.
