



Welcome to Group Advising!

At group advising you will check your progress towards graduation and receive advising about what classes to take next semester. You must come to a group advising session to receive your PIN to register for next semester.

SIGN UP

- Sign up for a group advising session in the ISET office McKee 227 or call 351-2929.
- Group advising sessions will be held in the ISET Advising Center, McKee 114.
- Choose the session based on your **current completed** credits classification: Freshman 0-29 cr., Sophomore 30-59 cr., Junior 60-89 cr., Senior 90+ cr.)

PREPARE

- Watch the PowerPoint Presentation posted on the ISET website (www.unco.edu/iset in News and Events –choose the PP based on your **current** classification), which you will view at your convenience **prior to advising**. **These have been streamlined and contain essential new information for where you are in the program, so please read carefully!** This PowerPoint will be available on the website for future reference. **You are responsible for this information, so we will refer you back to the PowerPoint for answers.**
- **New ISET Graduation Requirement form, which you need to fill out according to your Academic Transcript on Ursa, prior to coming to group advising. You can find this on the ISET website under “Forms.”**
- Gather materials from the ISET website or the ISET office, McKee 227.
- **Come prepared** with an updated check list and a revised four-year plan with courses for next semester. Remember it is your responsibility to be informed, so bring a list of your questions.
- **Make sure that you do a Graduation Check and apply for graduation as soon as you have registered for EDEL 445/446.**
- Schedule an appointment with an advisor prior to Feb. 20 if you have not yet developed a four-year plan.

INDIVIDUAL APPOINTMENTS: you may make an individual appointment if you have more questions or personal issues after attending a group advising session. PIN numbers are only available at group advising.

SUMMER REGISTRATION: Opens on April 2 for **everyone**. You do not need a PIN for summer registration. See the Registrar’s page for more information.

SENIORS STUDENT TEACHING FALL 2012: You do not need to attend group advising. PTEP will register you for EDEL 453 and 454 (or 444 for ESL). If you need to register for ET 347 or CH 303, you will need to contact the ISET office for your PIN.
