



## Welcome to Group Advising!

At group advising you will check your progress towards graduation and receive advising about what classes to take next semester. You must come to a group advising session to receive your PIN to register for next semester.

### SIGN UP

- Sign up for an advising session in the ISET office McKee 227 or call 351-2929.
- Advising sessions will be held in the ISET Advising Center, McKee 114.
- Choose the session based on [what you will enroll in next semester](#). Classification is based on how many credits you will have completed [after this semester](#) (Fr. 0-29 cr., So. 30-59 cr., Jr. 60-89 cr., Sr. 90-120 cr.)

### PREPARE

- Watch the Power Point Presentation, appropriate to where you are in the program, posted on the ISET website ([www.unco.edu/iset](http://www.unco.edu/iset)), which you will view at your convenience. **prior to advising.** This Power Point will be available on the website for future reference.
- Gather materials from the ISET website or the ISET office, McKee 227.
- **Come prepared** with an updated check list and a revised four-year plan with courses for next semester. Remember it is your responsibility to be informed, so bring a list of your questions.

**INDIVIDUAL APPOINTMENTS:** you may make an individual appointment if you have more questions or personal issues after attending a group advising session. The book to sign up for individual appointments will not be available after Oct. 9. PIN numbers are only available at group advising.

**FALL/SPRING INTERIM REGISTRATION:** Begins Oct .14, you must be in good standing and have completed 24 credits to register for an Interim class. See the Registrar's page for more information: <http://www.unco.edu/regrec/registration/Pre-registration> .

## Group Advising Schedule Fall 2009

*Group 1-- STUDENT TEACHING EDEL 453 and 454 (or 444 for ESL): no ISET advising needed. PTEP will register you for these classes. You will need a PIN to register for ET 347 or CH 303. (seniors)*

**Group 2--** Students who have previously completed EDFE 110 and have already taken some PTEP classes. For example, if you will be taking any of the following courses in Spring 2010, choose one of these group sessions:

- **Methods courses and field experience** (any of the following: EDFE 120, EDEL 450, EDEL 445, EDEL 446, SCED 475)
- **Continuing PTEP prerequisites** (any of the following: EDEL 350, EDF 370, EDSE 430, PSY 347, ET 247) and/or **ISET/Concentration courses**. (juniors/seniors)
