He held several positions in the College of Education, including Teaching Assistant; Area Coordinator; Associate Dean; Acting Director; Dean; and Director of the Division of Elementary, Middle School, Early Childhood Education and Reading.

He received a B. S in Social Sciences from St. Cloud State University in 1957, a M. S. in Educational Administration from George Washington University in 1961, a Ed.D. in Educational Administration Curriculum & Instruction from the University of Northern Colorado in 1966.
