FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)

1. Is this program accredited by the American Speech Language Hearing Association?

Yes, the program is accredited through 2009.

2. Do I need to have an undergraduate degree in Communication Disorders to participate in this program?

This program assumes an undergraduate background in Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology, or Communication Disorders. Students who do not have such a background must complete a core of undergraduate courses prior to beginning the program. 3. May I attend the program on a part-time basis?

No. The on campus program is a full-time program. Students begin in the fall and stay together as a cohort through the six-semester program.

4. Is financial aid available?

You may apply for financial aid through the University's Financial Aid Office. University financial aid includes scholarships, student loans, work-study, and other programs. In order to be eligible for these university-wide program, it is necessary for you to submit a **"Free Application for Federal Student Aid" (FAFSA) by February 15, 2009**. Financial statements submitted after March 1, 2009, will be processed by will receive a lower priority and funding will be subject to funds available. The FAFSA forms and information are available through financial aid offices and public high schools in your area and through the UNC Office of Student Financial Resources.
