Applicants should include curriculum vita or resume, letter of application describing teaching and related experience, 3 letters of recommendation, list of courses that the candidate is qualified to teach with an indication of preferences, and official college transcripts indicating all coursework and undergraduate and graduate degrees earned. Applications to the hiring pool may be submitted at any time but should be submitted by June 30, 2007 for full consideration for the fall semester assignments.
