This course is a request from District 6 to provide a ‘second level’ statistics course for high school students who have taken AP Statistics in high school and want to pursue additional topics in statistics. The course is submitted as experimental (STAT 298). If successful Fall 2010, the course will be added to the 10-11 catalog as STAT 260.
