1. Chair (Faculty from the SON with doctoral research (DR) endorsement – co chair might be possible if desired chair does not have DR status)
2. & 3. Two faculty members: one of which must be from the SON; the other may be from SON or a related discipline or from another University (both must have Graduate faculty status)
4. A faculty representative from another department (student/advisor may suggest an individual to the graduate school; the graduate school formally appoints this individual by policy)

**Footnote 2: Only *completed* copies of the proposal are distributed and reviewed by the entire committee; the completed proposal (polished) must be provided to all committee members 3 weeks prior to the scheduled *Proposal Hearing*. All students are required to come to campus for the The Proposal Hearing- this formal presentation requires all committee members to be present= proposal defense.
