This worksheet is a recommended schedule to complete your bachelor's degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

Notes

- 1 Students will be admitted on a staggered basis. One half will start in the summer session, the other half in the fall. The track shown is the track for summer admission, graduating at the end of spring. The fall admission track will graduate at the end of summer.
- 2 Liberal Arts Core requires a minimum of 40 credits hours; at least 31 credit hours of these shall be taken in areas 1 through 6.
- 3 Students should apply for graduation in Carter Hall 3002 upon completion of their junior year.
- 4 The RN student is awarded 40 hours of upper division nursing course work per the Colorado Articulation Agreement upon completion of one semester of full time nursing course work at UNC. Total credits required for RN's (120).
- 5 A minimum grade of C or better (C- is not acceptable) or satisfactory in all nursing courses required for progression to the next semester must be earned.
