Position Title: Assistant Professor, Speech-Language Pathology **Position number:** F99924

Qualifications and Experience:

Ph.D. or equivalent required in Speech-Language Pathology, Communication Sciences & Disorders, or related area. ABD candidates with completion prior to December 31, 2008, will be considered. Preferred areas of expertise include neurogenic communication disorders, voice disorders, motor speech disorders, medical speech-language pathology, experience in acute care or rehabilitation hospital, and interest in or experience with online teaching. Preference given to holders of Certificate of Clinical Competence – Speech Language Pathology (CCC-SLP).

Position Description:

Assistant Professor, tenure-track, 9-month appointment. Responsibilities include undergraduate and graduate teaching & advising, supervision of graduate research, scholarly activity and development of external funding, and clinical supervision.

Salary and Benefits:

Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience. Benefits may include health, life, and dental insurance, as well as a selection of several defined contribution retirement programs. Dependents and Souses of UNC Employees who are employed as 0.5 FTE or above are entitled to and eligible for Dependent Tuition Grants. These tuition grants will cover in-state tuition charges.
