Position Title: Assistant Professor of Human Rehabilitative Services **Position Number:** F99799

Qualifications and Experience:

This nine-month tenure-track appointment, with the possibility of summer teaching, requires an earned doctorate in Rehabilitation or a related field, as well as background and expertise in the field of Rehabilitation. Candidates who are ABD will be considered if Doctorate will be completed by August 15, 2008. Certified Rehabilitation Counselor certification is required. Experience teaching at the university level, involvement in scholarly activity and commitment to both undergraduate and graduate education are considered to be desirable qualifications. Teaching responsibilities will be in the undergraduate and graduate programs of Human Rehabilitative Services. The undergraduate degree is a Bachelor of Science in Human Services, and courses are taught by Rehabilitation faculty and faculty in Community Health and Gerontology. The graduate program includes a Master of Arts in Rehabilitation Counseling, and a Doctorate in Human Rehabilitation. Experience with student advisement and working with professional organizations in the field is also desirable. Evidence of instruction, counseling supervision, and knowledge of CORE accreditation is preferred.

Salary and Benefits:

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Benefits include health, life, and dental insurance, as well as a selection of several defined contribution retirement programs. Other benefits may be available based on position.
