Position Title: Assistant, Associate or Full Professor of Nursing

- Completed Advanced Practice Family Nurse Practitionership program and/or Doctorate of Nursing Practice program in nursing from an accredited School of Nursing
- Completed PhD in Nursing from an accredited School of Nursing or doctorate in a related field at time of hire
- Scholarly track record consistent with the rank sought (Assistant, Associate or Full Professor) at the University of Northern Colorado
- Record of teaching in graduate and/or undergraduate nursing education

- National Certification as an advanced practice nurse

Position Description: Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor of Nursing; faculty position providing leadership for an Advanced Practice Nursing (APN) program with a Family Nurse Practitioner and Clinical Nurse Specialist focus. This is a full time, nine month tenure-track appointment in the School of Nursing. Primary responsibilities will include coordination of the Advanced Practice Nursing program, leadership for the future Doctorate of Nursing Practice (DNP) program, mentorship of part time APN faculty, scholarly activity, classroom and clinical instruction in the Advanced Practice Nursing program and graduate curriculum, service on school and university committees and continued practice 8 hrs per week (contracted through the school).

Salary and Benefits: Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Benefits include health, life, and dental insurance as well as a selection of several defined contribution retirement programs. Other benefits may be available based on position.
