**Minimum Requirements**

Earned doctorate from an accredited university in dietetics or a related discipline, and dietetic registration. Evidence of teaching, scholarship and professional service. ABD status will be considered; however degree completion is required for appointment to this tenure-track position beginning August 20, 2007.

**Preferred Qualifications**

Evidence of effective university teaching using a variety of teaching methods, successful grant application, willingness to advise students, experience with collaborative/outreach partnerships on a campus and surrounding community, and ability to provide leadership to ADA accredited programs. Membership in The American Dietetic Association.

Position Description:

This is a full-time, nine-month tenure-track appointment in the School of Human Sciences within the College of Natural and Health Sciences at the University of Northern Colorado. Responsibilities: Teach undergraduate and graduate courses in accredited Didactic Program in Dietetics and accredited dietetic internship in areas of food, nutrition and/or dietetics; typical teaching responsibilities include three courses per semester with courses aligned to the candidate's areas of expertise in nutrition, food science, food service, or nutrition policy; advise students; conduct publishable scholarly activity in area of expertise; participate in service to the school, university and professional organizations.

Salary and Benefits:

Commensurate with qualifications and experience. Benefits include health, life, and dental insurance as well as a selection of several defined contribution retirement programs. Other benefits may be available based on position.
