Position Title: Assistant Professor of Mathematical Sciences **Position Number:** 99651

Qualifications and Experience:

Minimum Requirements: Ph.D. in Mathematics required. All fields considered. Successful candidate must show evidence of potential for excellent teaching and research.

Preferred Qualifications: Experience with or interest in innovative teaching at the college level is highly desirable. A strong interest in our Educational Mathematics Ph.D. program and/or our K-12 mathematics education programs is also desirable. Ability and willingness to teach computer science or statistics a plus.

Position Description This is a full-time, tenure track position in the School of Mathematical Sciences. A full-time assignment typically includes teaching nine hours per semester in addition to research and service responsibilities. Teaching assignment may span both undergraduate and graduate courses and may include opportunities in off-campus programs or partner schools.

Salary and Benefits:

Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience. Benefits include health, life, and dental insurance as well as a selection of several defined contribution retirement programs. Other benefits may be available based on position.
