**Discussion Items**

1. Faculty Senate has requested that a committee be assembled to discuss what constitutes academic dishonesty and procedures for reporting and discipline.
2. The university is examining the utilization of scholarships with the goal of maximizing their use and impact.
3. A search is taking place for the VP of Advancement. The proposed start date is July 1.
4. After Debbie Pirera reconciles the FY10 budget, Dean Battles will meet with the Directors to discuss plans for funding critical needs.
5. Summer 2010 registration begins April 4. Summer compensation will fall under the new compensation plan. The plan is available at [http://www.unco.edu/nhs/pdf/sum\\_compensation\\_model.pdf](http://www.unco.edu/nhs/pdf/sum_compensation_model.pdf).
6. The Academic Working Group discussed two final restructuring proposals. Their feedback has been posted on the web at [http://www.unco.edu/nhs/academic\\_restructure.html](http://www.unco.edu/nhs/academic_restructure.html). The Leadership Team will discuss the proposals on March 25.
7. Schools are moving forward with searches. We have three successful searches thus far.
8. The Team discussed and edited the draft NHS Committee Structure and Guidelines, the Evaluation and Reappointment of Directors, and the NHS Committee Structure and Guidelines for Science and Mathematics Education Coordinating Committee documents.
9. NHS has raised over \$2.9 million which is about 41 percent of our College's \$7 million campaign goal.
10. The spring Advisory Board meeting has been set for Friday, April 9 from 8-12PM in Ross 3240.
11. The deadline for honored alumni nominations is April 1.
12. Dean Battles continues to work on comprehensive reviews. Annual reviews and term faculty reappointments were due to the Dean's office on March 1. Tenure-track reappointments are due March 15.
13. The draft Academic Advising instrument has been disseminated to the college for feedback.
14. The Academic Scholar Awards Ceremony is Sunday, March 28 at 2PM in the UC. Curt Weibel will be the featured alumnus speaker.
15. The Dean's office is finalizing the details for the Student Research Celebration. Formal invitations have gone out. On-campus invitations will be sent out next week.
