### Title on co-curricular transcript

Student Research Project

### Criteria required to merit recognition

- Research project must result in a measurable product such as a submitted report or manuscript, presentation at university research day, presentation at a local, regional, national, or international conference, presentation at a school/department seminar, etc.
- If the student has received credit for any portion of the research project as part of formal coursework, the research project must extend beyond the requirements of that coursework.
- An NHS faculty member will validate evidence of work.

### Procedure for verification that activity has been performed satisfactorily

Students pursuing mentored undergraduate student research in NHS are required to have the research project validated by an NHS faculty member and the unit leader prior to publishing on the student's co-curricular transcript. The following form should be filled out by the student and submitted to the faculty member for endorsement. The form should then be sent to the unit leader for endorsement, after which the unit leader will forward this form to the Dean's office requesting inclusion of the item on the student's co-curricular transcript.
