Note: Any student receiving a grade of "D" or lower in a required SES core course must retake the course until a grade of "C" or higher is achieved.

Prior to taking SES 490, students must pass Competency Assessment I with a grade of 70% or better.

Prior to registering for SES 492, students must have a GPA of 2.7 or above in the SES prefix courses and pass Competency Assessment II with a grade of 70% or better. Competency Assessment II is taken in the SES 490 course. Competency Assessments may be repeated as necessary.
