**Before You Come to New Student Orientation or Parent Orientation**

If your parent or other guest will be attending Orientation with you, they need to sign up for Parent Orientation. They can sign up at [www.unco.edu/summerconf/Register/register.html](http://www.unco.edu/summerconf/Register/register.html).

What to bring to Orientation:

- **Your UNC Bear Number (typically 801XXXXXX)** – this is your student identification number and will be used by many offices, so memorize it ASAP
- Casual dress and comfortable walking shoes
- Personal belongings (change of clothes, toiletries, shower shoes, bug spray) for two days
- Results of your Spanish Placement Exam-If you are a student who is intending to take a Spanish course at UNC, you must take the Spanish Placement exam and bring the results with you to orientation. The Placement Exam can be accessed on-line at [www.unco.edu/hispstds/span\\_placement\\_exam.html](http://www.unco.edu/hispstds/span_placement_exam.html). You will work with an advisor from the Spanish program at orientation
- If you have not sent your immunization records to the Student Health Center, you should bring them to orientation
- Your Bear Pride!

What to send to the University:

- Transcripts from any other institution from which you will receive college credit (including college courses taken in high school)
  - Send transcripts to the Office of Admissions at least two weeks before your session; if that is not possible, bring transcripts with you to Orientation
- Scores from Advanced Placement (AP) and/or International Baccalaureate (IB) exams
  - Send scores to the Office of Admissions at least two weeks before your session; if you have not received your scores at the time of Orientation, notify your Orientation Leader at orientation
- Immunization documentation
  - Send immunization documents to the Student Health Center at least two weeks before your session; if that is not possible, bring documentation to Orientation

## While You Are Here

**Parking:** Parking is free in both the south and north lots at the University Center. There is no need to park anywhere else during Orientation, but if you wish to park somewhere else, you will need to buy a day pass from one of the daily parking dispensers or from Parking Services in Gray Hall.

**Check-in:** Check in will take place at Wiebking Hall, just across the street from the University Center on the northeast corner of 10<sup>th</sup> Ave and 20<sup>th</sup> St.

- Check-In will begin at 9:00am and will remain open until 9:45am. If you are late, please go directly to the University Center.
- Students and parents will receive program materials, meal cards, and room key.
- At this time you may leave your belongings in your room. You will not be able to access your room again until the program concludes in the evening.

**After checking in:** Both New Student Orientation and Parent Orientation will begin at the University Center at 10:00am.

- Students can get their picture ID taken at the UNC Card Office, which is located in the upstairs level of the University Center, during this time.
