## **Before You Come to New Student Orientation or Parent Orientation**

If your parent or other guest will be attending Orientation with you, they need to sign up for Parent Orientation. They can sign up at [www.unco.edu/summerconf/Register/register.html](http://www.unco.edu/summerconf/Register/register.html).

### What to bring to Orientation:

- **Your UNC Bear Number (typically 801XXXXXX)** – this is your student identification number and will be used by many offices, so memorize it ASAP
- Casual dress and comfortable walking shoes
- Results of your Spanish Placement Exam-If you are a student who is intending to take a Spanish course at UNC, you must take the Spanish Placement exam and bring the results with you to orientation. The Placement Exam can be accessed on-line at [www.unco.edu/hispstds/span\\_placement\\_exam.html](http://www.unco.edu/hispstds/span_placement_exam.html). You will work with an advisor from the Spanish program at orientation
- If you have not sent your immunization records to the Student Health Center, you should bring them to orientation
- Your Bear Pride!

### What to send to the University:

- Transcripts from ALL other institutions from which you will receive college credit
  - Send transcripts to the Office of Admissions at least two weeks before your session; if that is not possible, bring transcripts with you to Orientation
- Immunization documentation
  - Send immunization documents to the Student Health Center at least two weeks before your session; if that is not possible, bring documentation to Orientation

## **While You Are Here**

**Parking:** Parking is free in both the south and north lots at the University Center. There is no need to park anywhere else during Orientation, but if you wish to park somewhere else, you will need to buy a day pass from one of the daily parking dispensers or from Parking Services in Gray Hall.

**Check-in:** Check in will take place at the University Center, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

- Check-In will begin at 8:15am and will remain open until 8:55am.
- Students and parents will receive program materials and meal cards

**After checking in:** Both New Student Orientation and Parent Orientation will begin at the University Center at 9:00am.

- Students can get their picture ID taken at the UNC Card Office, which is located in the upstairs level of the University Center, during this time

CANCELLATIONS MUST BE MADE A FULL 7 DAYS BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED ORIENTATION SESSION TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A REFUND. Each Parent Orientation reservation is charged a \$5.00 non-refundable reservation fee. Refunds will be processed:

- For June sessions during the first week in July
- For July sessions during the first week in August
- For August sessions during the first week in September

Please DO NOT make another reservation. Changes must be made a full 7 days before the scheduled orientation session.

**Arriving Early/Moving Into Your Residence Hall Room**
