

# International Students

## - waiving their taxes

If an International Student wishes to be exempt from **Federal** and **Colorado** taxes, they need to see Lacey Snyder in Carter Hall. Lacey will review the treaty with their country and see if this exemption is permitted. Form 8233 would be completed and submitted to the Government. Lacey will then inform payroll to make the student exempt from **Federal and Colorado taxes only and bring Payroll the new W4.**

*If an International Student falls below the 6 credit hours during the academic year and 3 credit hours during the summer they will be taxed with **Medicare** and **Student Retirement** (Tiaa-Cref).*

*International Students are not to work over 20 hours during a normal school week. Up to 40 hours can be worked during a break or summer.*
