

a. Because of funds

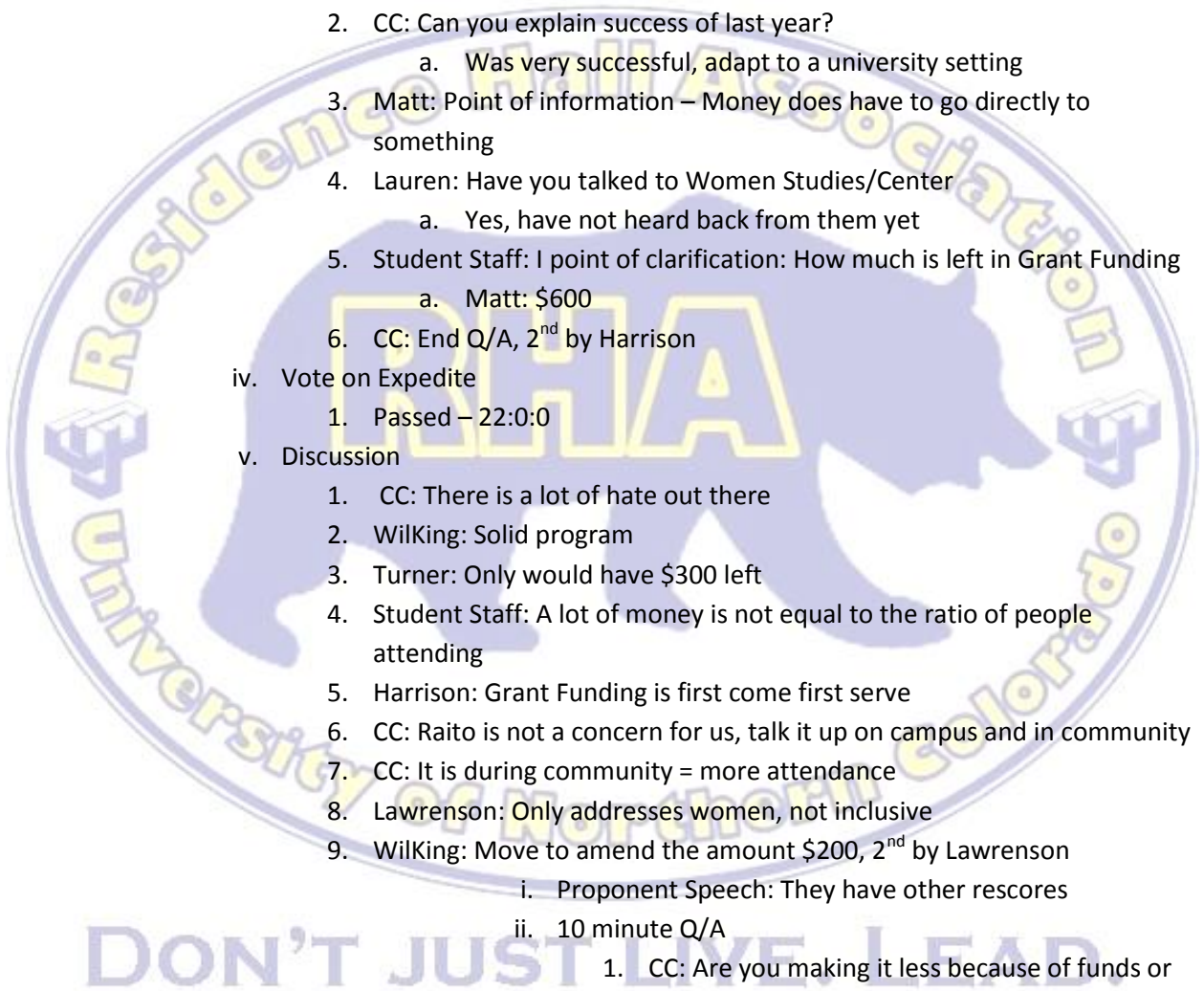
2. Harrison: Move to end Q/A, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Student Staff
