# 2014-2015 Undergraduate Alumni Survey Report

The 2014-2015 Undergraduate Alumni Survey was conducted from June through August 2016 by the Office of Assessment at the University of Northern Colorado. A sample of 2,032 Undergraduate Alumni who graduated in Summer 2014, Fall 2014, and Spring 2015 was asked to provide information about their employment status and pursuit of graduate-level education. Of these 2,032 alumni, 468 responded to the survey for a 23% response rate.
